## MONTANA SAPPHIRE COLLECTION

A New Jewelry Line By Allison Neumann

On September 11, 2010, San Diego Jewelry Designer Allison Neumann will unveil a new jewelry line containing Montana Sapphires from a private family holding. The pieces are made from recycled and refined gold and sapphires from Montana deposits. The launch event will take place from 7-11pm at The Glashaus, located at 1815-b Main Street, in the Barrio Logan neighborhood of San Diego, where Neumann has a studio. The main gallery of Glashaus will host the event, a locale that routinely draws art crowds by the hundreds.

Montana Sapphires are often heat-treated to alter their color and clarity, an enhancement that is widely used for this gemstone. However, the sapphires in this collection are not treated, which makes them unique. The natural beauty of the stones will be portrayed through a series of images by a world-renowned gemstone and jewelry photographer. The urban chic vibe of Glashaus coupled with a dazzling display of fine jewelry should prove to be a unique evening for jewelry aficionados and collectors alike.

Allison Neumann is a Gemological Institute of America (GIA) Graduate with 10 years of experience in the jewelry industry. She uses recycled gold and silver, conflict-free and fair trade stones.
