

The Kansas Interagency Council on Early Childhood Developmental Services (“State ICC”) is pleased to announce the opportunity for appointment of a parent member. The State ICC is an advisory body created in both state and federal statutes. It has the mission *to ensure that a comprehensive service delivery system of integrated services is available in Kansas to all children with a disability or who experience (or are at risk for) developmental delays from birth through age 5 and their families*. Parents comprise at least 20% of the State ICC membership. Parents should have knowledge of, or experience with, programs for infants and toddlers with disabilities. All parent members must be the parent of a child with a disability age 12 or under with at least one member the parent of a child with a disability age 6 or under. Parent members may not be employees of a public or private agency involved in providing early intervention services.

State ICC members are appointed by Governor Brownback to serve a term of four years.
