#### Driving Directions:

**From 610 West Loop** - take the San Felipe exit; go west on San Felipe; the 5th light is St. James; turn left onto St. James.

**From Highway 59** - take the Chimney Rock exit; go north on Chimney Rock; turn right on San Felipe; the first light is St. James; turn right onto St. James.

**From I-10** - take the Wirt/Chimney Rock exit; go south on Chimney Rock; turn left onto San Felipe; the first light is St. James, turn right onto St. James.

1900 is the 4th building on the right. You may park in the visitor parking around the building or in the basement of the garage. Suite 880 on the 8th floor.
