Important Program Information

Our system of positive reinforcement:

We love giving our students lots of reasons to listen, learn, and follow instructions. We look for opportunities to praise students for making great choices like following directions and working well with friends. We encourage good behaviors with high fives, fun activities, and words of praise.

These young students are learning to learn, and we understand that. We encourage curiosity since that is how kids learn. However, it is often necessary to redirect and remind students, helping them remain on task so that they can get the most out of our Sensational Kids curriculum.

In the case of misbehavior, students will first be reminded of the correct behavior. Repeated misbehaviors will be discouraged through the use of time outs. In the unlikely event that a student's misbehavior becomes repetitive or raises concerns regarding safety or well-being, we will contact the parent so that we can partner in our efforts to help the student learn.

We encourage good nutrition:

We serve minimally processed snacks that are free of artificial dyes. If your child has special nutritional needs or food allergies please ask our staff for a nutrition checklist so that our staff can work with you to make sure that his/her special needs are met. Also, we ask that parents NOT send sugary snacks or treats for the class. If you would like to send a special treat to celebrate your child's birthday, for example, please check with us so that we may recommend a healthy treat that meets our nutritional guidelines.

Separation anxiety:

Separation anxiety is normal, and we are eager to help your child make the transition from home to class in a positive way. During orientation you will receive a picture book to read to your child. We recommend that you enjoy time with your child, reading the book and talking with him/her. Upon arrival for class please be prompt in dropping off your child. Walk your child in, transfer his/her care to the teacher, give a hug and kiss, and be sure to say goodbye before leaving. Separation anxiety is often a challenge for both the parent and the child; we understand and are sympathetic to this new experience. Please do not prolong the drop off process, but keep your goodbyes short and sincere. Please do not sneak out while your child is preparing for class; this is stressful for your child and it can exacerbate his or her anxiety. If your child has had a particularly difficult time in the past with separation anxiety please share your concerns with us so that we can take further steps to help him/her adjust. Drop off begins at 9:00am for the Toddler Class and 9:15am for the Preschool Class. Activities begin at 9:15am and 9:30am, respectively.

What to bring:

- We recommend packing a small tote bag that is easy for the child to manage.
- All students should bring a complete change of clothes. Additional changes of clothes may be required for Toddler Class students who are potty training.
- Toddler Class students need five diapers and a package of wipes.
- Be sure to label all items with the student's name.
- Please **do not** bring toys from home unless requested as a component of a class project.
