Students must create a poster that demonstrates the theme "Bring Our Missing Children Home".

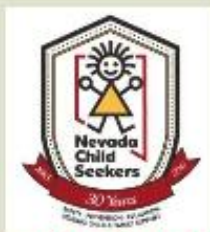
- ❖ The finished poster must be 8 ½ x 14 inches.
- ❖ The slogan "Bring Our Missing Children Home" must appear somewhere on the poster.
- ❖ Posters must be created by hand. Posters with printed images, collages, and stamping are not eligible.

- ❖ The poster must be submitted with a completed application, which includes a description of the poster and a brief biography of the artist.
- ❖ Posters must be submitted to your state contest manager for local judging.
