WHAT IS OFFERED

Flexibility in the program - depending on each school's needs - we can schedule:

- **One-time youth empowerment assembly**
- **Schedule up to three events per school year**
 - Beginning of year – Presentation on bullying prevention
 - Mid-year – Presentation on kindness and respect
 - End-of-year – Presentation on youth empowerment
- **Create a club on campus that encompasses a youth leadership component** (NCS will train site advisor and supply materials and handbook)

BACKGROUNDS & SCREENINGS

- Nevada Child Seekers representatives will follow the "Volunteer Assistant" procedures with C.C.S.D. (fingerprinting, background checks, etc. for a badge).
- Any lunch events, assemblies, banners, etc. will follow the approval protocol for each school.
- Nevada Child Seekers will not collect personal information from students.



BE BRAVE CLUB PROTOCOLS

- Nevada Child Seekers will strictly adhere to established procedures for forming clubs at each school.
- Nevada Child Seekers will work in concert with the site advisor at each school.
- Student information will solely be under the purview of each school advisor.



STUDENT INFORMATION

- Schools will receive the CCSD CCF-588 Annual Release Form for parents to sign. Only students with the release form will be photographed or recorded.
- Be Brave surveys will never ask for personal information and are solely used to demonstrate an increase in knowledge for grant reporting.

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
