



SFX 2015 Summer Reading Requirement for Spanish

Note: Grade level refers to that for 2015 -2016 school year.

All students will read the book The Very Hungry Caterpillar (La oruga muy Hambriente) in Spanish and do the following assignment. Grade level assignments are listed below:

Kindergarten - Draw the main character and label in Spanish La mariposa (the butterfly).

First and Second grade will draw and label the four stages of the butterfly in Spanish. El huevo (the egg), la oruga (the caterpillar), el capullo (the cocoon) and la Mariposa (the butterfly).

Third - Fifth grade

Students will draw and label the four stages of the butterfly in Spanish.

El huevo (the egg), la oruga (the caterpillar), el capullo (the cocoon) and la Mariposa (the butterfly).

Also list the seven days of the week and draw and label what the caterpillar eats on each day. Ex. Una manzana, dos peras, etc...

Sixth – Eighth grade

Students will draw and label the four stages of the butterfly in Spanish.

El huevo (the egg), la oruga (the caterpillar), el capullo (the cocoon) and la Mariposa (the butterfly).

Also list the seven days of the week and draw and label what the caterpillar eats on each day.

Using the verb to eat -comer in the present tense students will translate the following sentences: ex. Yo como

1. I eat an apple.
2. You eat an apple
3. You (formal/polite) eat two pears.
4. He eats three plums.
5. She eats three plums.
6. We eat four strawberries.
7. You guys eat five oranges.
8. They (just boys) eat a leaf.
9. They (just girls) eat a leaf.

* All fluent Spanish speakers will write a 5-7 sentence short summary of the story in Spanish and translate the sentences above using the verb comer in the present tense
