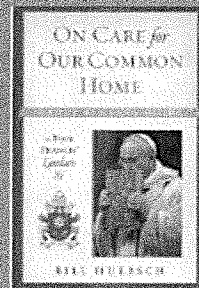
## LAUDATO SI: PRAISED BE TO YOU

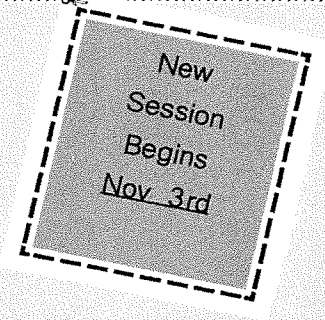

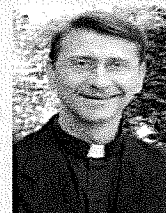

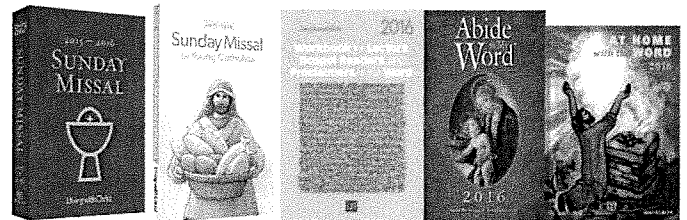
