## IGNATIAN SPIRITUALITY

**Ignatian spirituality** is one of the most influential and pervasive spiritual outlooks of our age. It is a **spirituality** for everyday life. It insists that God is present in our world and active in our lives. It is a pathway to deeper prayer, good decisions guided by keen discernment, and an active life of service to others. There is a story behind it.

### **1. It begins with a wounded soldier daydreaming on his sickbed.**

Ignatian spirituality is rooted in the experiences of Ignatius Loyola (1491-1556), a Basque aristocrat whose conversion to a fervent Christian faith began while he was recovering from war wounds. Ignatius, who founded the Jesuits, gained many insights into the spiritual life in the course of a decades long spiritual journey during which he became expert at helping others deepen their relationship with God. Its basis in personal experience makes Ignatian spirituality an intensely practical spirituality, well suited to laymen and laywomen living active lives in the world.

## UNDERSTANDING CATHOLICISM

Explore the early development of the Church, many of its problems, and how those conditions mimic issues facing the Church today. In many ways those same conditions exist today. We will discuss those similarities and how various religions interpret the major teachings of Jesus. Sessions are open to all.
