SIXTH SUNDAY OF EASTER

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

Today we celebrate the Sixth Sunday of Easter. In the gospel for today, John 15:9, again reminds us of God's great love for us: Jesus said to his disciples:

"As the Father loves me, so I also love you.

Remain in my love.

If you keep my commandments, you will remain in my love, just as I have kept my Father's commandments and remain in his love.

I have told you this so that my joy may be in you and your joy might be complete."

These are words to ponder. You can read these words over and over; gently, quietly let them wash over you and let your heart be moved with gratitude for God's great gift to you.

Today, in the United States, we celebrate Mother's Day. People will be finding ways to express their love for a person by some gift or other. Given the scripture quote above, God gives us his love, his YES to who we are through his Son and the Holy Spirit so that our joy may be complete.

St. Ignatius in his spiritual writings believed that the first person the Risen Jesus appeared to was his mother. You can imagine that scene. Mary said YES to God at the time of the Annunciation and lived out that YES throughout her life. She was with Jesus to the very end, a painful end. Then, the Resurrection. Jesus came to his mother and embraced her; her soul was overcome with joy. Jesus had fulfilled her YES.

As we honor Mothers today, give a thought about the Blessed Mother. Thank her for her example of faithful love. Let her embrace you in the spirit of resurrection joy. Know that she stands by you as she did with her Son, in good times and in difficult times. She is there to support your YES so that you may remain in God's love and keep his commandments. God bless all the families of our parish.



Before I Sleep; I Say Thank You

With bright and playful illustrations, *Before I Sleep: I Say Thank You* uses a simple bedtime story to help children develop a nightly habit of prayer and gratitude. ***With its roots in the Examen prayer*** *Before I Sleep: I Say Thank You* takes readers through the nighttime routine of one little boy with his mother. As they reflect on the day, he recalls both things that he could have done better and blessings throughout his day. *Before I Sleep: I Say Thank You* begins with a note "For Grown-ups" that touches on the Examen prayer and suggests ways to start forming the habit of gratitude and prayer at the end of the day. The note is followed by a bedtime story which shows one family's nighttime prayer routine. The book ends with a simplified version of the Examen that gives young children an example of ways they can be grateful in their own lives. Ideal for children ages 4-8
