



SANCTURARY HEARING LOOP IS NOW OPERATIONAL

Last week, Pro Sound and Video completed installation of the new hearing loop in the Sanctuary. This new system connected to our sound system and can be used with any hearing aid that has a "T-Coil". About 80% of today's hearing aids contain a T-Coil. If your's has a T-Coil it can be turned on by turning on the T-Switch. The sound crew volunteers are not experts on hearing aid technology so please contact your audiologist for additional information and instruction with your T-Coil equipped hearing aid.

In addition, we have 4 receivers with headsets that operate on the same system. These receivers are a small box about the same size as a cell phone that is specially designed to receive the hearing loop signal. The receiver has a neck cord. It is highly recommended that the receiver be worn around your neck so that it is held vertically. The receiver is designed to receive the signal in a vertical position. If held in any other position, it likely will not work. On the top of the receiver is the "Off-On-Volume" knob. The sound crew will turn it on for you but it is up to every person to adjust the volume. The sound crew will help you operate it the first time if you need any assistance.

The receivers do have a slight background hum which is normal. The system works best with hearing aids. The T-Coil and your hearing aid are designed to filter out any extraneous noise as your hearing aid is "tuned" to your particular hearing loss.

If you have any volume issues with your T-Cell equipped hearing aid, please contact the sound crew. We may have to adjust the broadcast signal over the first few weeks of operation to ensure that everyone's hearing aid is picking up the signal appropriately. Just let the sound crew (Mike Sanderson in particular) know if you are having issues.
