VOLUNTARY THREE-TIER FEE STRUCTURE

TIER 1: fees are color-coded blue (e.g. \$290 • \$370 • \$450)

This amount is our historically subsidized rate. You may be surprised to learn that these prices do not reflect the true cost of offering a week of summer camp. These reduced rates are made possible by mission dollars we receive from the Presbytery of West Virginia, local Presbyterian churches, and individuals who value the impact Bluestone has on children, youth, and families.

TIER 2: fees are color-coded red (e.g. \$290 • \$370 • \$450)

This middle amount is a partially subsidized rate. By choosing to pay a little more, you help support the ongoing summer camp ministry of Bluestone.

TIER 3: fees are color-coded green (e.g. \$290 • \$370 • \$450)

This amount most closely reflects the true cost for a week of camp at Bluestone. The price includes things like utilities, grounds upkeep, insurance, buildings maintenance, etc. By choosing this tier, you help us do more with the mission funding we receive. You help us make needed upgrades and repairs, and you enable Bluestone to grow in the future.

This program is voluntary and in no way influences the camp experience that children receive. Tier 2 and Tier 3 payments for camp (less the corresponding Tier 1 amount) will be received and acknowledged as tax deductible donations to Bluestone.

We believe that every child should experience the powerful impact that summer camp provides regardless of income. For this reason, we have financial aid available through the Molly Gant Scholarship Fund. If our fees present a challenge for your family, please contact us.




"Bluestone Camp and Retreat is an accredited member of the American Camping Association".

HOW DO I GET THERE?

Take exit 139. This exit is about 20 miles east of the I-77 and I-64 junction.

Follow Rt. 20 into Hinton.

At the traffic light, turn right and cross a bridge. At the end of the bridge, turn left.

Travel down that road until you pass a Dairy Queen.

Shortly after you pass the DQ, turn left (toward Alderson) onto Route 3.

Cross the bridge and veer right.

Shortly you'll pass an Exxon station.

If you have less than 1/4 of a tank, we suggest that you stop for gas.

Two blocks past the Exxon Station, there will be a sign for Bluestone Conference Center. Turn right onto Cedar Avenue, and then veer left up Zion Mountain Road.

Follow the signs! Veer right at every fork in the road. It's about a 10-mile drive.
