



The Reverend Doctor Thomas Tewell will be in Charleston at First Presbyterian Church, on May 3 and 4. An ordained Presbyterian Minister for over 35 years, Dr. Tewell has served churches, large and small in Pennsylvania, New Jersey, Texas, and New York, leading the 5100 member Memorial Drive Presbyterian Church in Houston, TX to become a “dollar for dollar” church. That means that for every dollar they spent on their own ministry, they gave a dollar away to ministry and service outside their church. He is currently Director of the Macedonia Project in Atlanta, GA, working with pastors of churches in that area to engender growth in health and strength of ministry in those churches. The Macedonia ministry has grown and prospered and produced nine other such efforts across the country. Dr. Tewell is in demand across the country as a preacher and lecturer, teaching and preaching in pulpits and at conferences from Princeton, Drew, San Francisco, Columbia, Fuller, and Pittsburgh Theological Seminaries, among others, to Chautauqua Institution and Montreat Conference Center to countless churches all over America.

Dr. Tewell will be speaking at First Presbyterian Church, located on the corner of Leon Sullivan Way and Virginia Street (16 Leon Sullivan Way) on Saturday morning, May 3 from 9:00 – 12:00, in the Church Dining Room.
