



Open for Submissions

Entries are now being accepted for the 2015 AIA Kentucky Honor Awards Program. For more than 50 years, this program has sought to honor and bring to public attention distinctive works of architecture created by Kentucky architects. Projects completed in the past 10 years are eligible. Past winners have ranged from single family homes to small commercial buildings to major public projects. Entries may be submitted only by an AIA Member Architect.

New Project Categories

We are pleased to announce that we've revised our project categories to better showcase for the Jury the diversity in project type and size of the entries. The Jury will be encouraged to recognize Honor, Merit and/or Citation Award status in any or all of these categories.

New Online Entry/Submission Process

We are also excited to introduce a revised submission process this year that incorporates a web-based single-stage entry/submission process that eliminates all print materials and mailing/delivery of files on CD. The entry fee (\$150 per project) and ALL descriptive information, digital photos and drawings will be submitted using the online system, which incorporates the PowerPoint template used in prior years, with only a few very minor changes. The requirements for quantity and format of photos and drawings remain the same. Entrants may begin a project submission, save work-in-progress, and return to complete the submission as time allows. It's straightforward, convenient, and can be accessed from anywhere.

Program Schedule

The submission deadline for the 2015 Honor Awards will be **10:00 p.m. on Monday July 20, 2015**. Entrants will be notified of results in early August. The awards will be announced to the public and presented to winners on Monday, October 12, 2015 during the AIA Ohio Valley Region Convention in Columbus, Ohio.
