## TREVOR DALEY APPOINTED LAWA DEPUTY EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS

(Los Angeles, California – May 20, 2016) Trevor Daley has been appointed Deputy

Executive Director, Chief of External Affairs for Los Angeles World Airports (LAWA).

Announcement of Daley's appointment was made by LAWA Chief Executive Officer Deborah Flint.

In his position, Daley will oversee and coordinate the efforts of the Government Affairs,

Public/Media Relations and Community Affairs divisions.

Since January 2013, Daley has served as United States Senator Dianne Feinstein's State Director, responsible for her state wide operations. Daley has worked for Feinstein for more than 16 years. As state director, he oversaw Feinstein's Los Angeles office and served as her senior advisor and strategist in representing the Senator in the State. Prior to joining the Senator's staff, Daley worked for former Los Angeles City Councilwoman Ruth Galanter.

"Trevor's wide range experience in consensus building, strategic planning, legislative affairs and leveraging of resources will greatly benefit LAWA," said Flint. "As we continue the \$14 billion Capital Improvement Program to transform LAX into a world class airport, Trevor will raise visibility and garner support from our constituents at the local, state, and Federal level, while leading and coordinating external affairs functions for all LAWA activities, including the Landside Access Modernization Program and guest experience."

Daley will begin his employment with LAWA on June 13, 2016.

## **About Los Angeles International Airport (LAX)**

LAX is the seventh busiest airport in the world and third in the United States. LAX served more than 74.9 million passengers in 2015. LAX offers 692 daily nonstop flights to 85 cities in the U.S. and 928 weekly nonstop flights to 67 cities in 34 countries on 59 commercial air carriers. LAX ranks 14th in the world and fifth in the U.S. in air cargo tonnage processed, with more than 2.1 million tons of air cargo valued at over \$86.9 billion. An economic study based on 2014 operations reported LAX generated 620,610 jobs in Southern California with labor income of \$37.3 billion and economic output (business revenues) of more than \$126.6 billion. This activity added \$6.2 billion to local and state revenues and \$8.7 billion in federal tax revenues. The study also reported that LAX's ongoing capital-improvement program creates an additional 121,640 annual jobs with labor income of \$7.6 billion and economic output of \$20.3 billion, \$966 million in state and local taxes, and \$1.6 billion in federal tax revenues.

LAX is part of a system of three Southern California airports – along with LA/Ontario International and Van Nuys general aviation – that are owned and operated by Los Angeles World Airports, a proprietary department of the City of Los Angeles that receives no funding from the City's general fund.
