




PROJECTS | MANAGED LANES

- Scheduled to open Spring/Summer 2018
- Managed lane interchanges at:
 - Hickory Grove Rd, Big Shanty Road, I-575, Roswell Road, Terrell Mill Road, I-285 and Akers Mill Road





PROJECTS | MANAGED LANES



- Major Cobb DOT projects related to GDOT managed lanes:
 - Bells Ferry Road
 - Big Shanty Road
 - Hickory Grove Road
- SPLOST 2016 projects
- Anticipate commuters' desire for access to managed lanes



PROJECTS | MORE GDOT PROJECTS

I-285 at Atlanta Road

- Scheduled completion
 September 2017
- \$46.9 million investment

U.S. 41 Bridge over Chattahoochee

- Substantially complete
- \$12.6 million investment

U.S. 41 Widening

- Paces Ferry Rd to Akers Mill Rd
- Estimated completion June 2016
- \$21 million project





PROJECTS | WINDY HILL ROAD

Five projects to improve safety and traffic flow


- Groundbreaking October 2014
- Complete in early 2017






IMPROVEMENTS | ACCESS ROUTES

IMPROVEMENTS | DEVELOPMENT OF REGIONAL IMPACT


- Stadium and project traffic
- DRI included 37 intersections
- Net new trips based on 2019 conditions
 - 57,000 daily (total both directions)
 - 5,000 p.m. peak (total both directions)
- Final notice of decision June 2014






IMPROVEMENTS | AREA PROJECTS

 - Circulator study





IMPROVEMENTS | COBB PKWY & CIRCLE 75/I-285 WB RAMP



IMPROVEMENTS | PROPOSED MULTI-USE BRIDGE OVER I-285



IMPROVEMENTS | WINDY RIDGE BRIDGE

- Widen approximately 42 feet to the north
 - 575 feet in length
- Enhanced pedestrian accommodations, plaza and green space
- Expected March 2017





IMPROVEMENTS | OTHER

- Cobb Pkwy at Windy Ridge Pkwy
 - Intersection improvements
- Cumberland Boulevard
 - Safety and operational
 - Akers Mill Road to Spring Road
 - Construction begins 2016
- I-285 Eastbound Ramp at Cobb Pkwy
 - Triple right-turn lanes
- Wayfinding Signs
 - Area guides
- Traffic Plan
- Pedestrian Plan



IMPROVEMENTS | GDOT FUNDING

• \$41.8 million in match funds

Project	Matched Funding
Cobb Parkway at I-285 Westbound off-ramp & Spring Road/Circle 75	\$4.7 million
Windy Ridge Parkway at Cobb Parkway	\$750,000
Windy Ridge Parkway from Circle 75 to Interstate North Parkway with bridge widening	\$7.75 million
I-285 Eastbound Ramp at Cobb Parkway	\$550,000
Interstate North Parkway from Interstate North Circle to Windy Ridge Parkway, including intersections	\$4.5 million
Interstate North Parkway from Windy Ridge Parkway to Marriott	\$1.45 million
Areawide – Variable Message Boards	\$5 million
Areawide – CCTV Cameras	\$2 million
Areawide – Interstate Signs	\$1 million
Windy Hill – Terrell Mill Connector	\$12 million
Cumberland Boulevard from Akers Mill to Spring Road	\$2.15 million

IMPROVEMENTS | CUMBERLAND CIRCULATOR



Study under way to determine circulator features, including:

- Best route options
- Convenient stop locations
- Specifications of circulator vehicles

A completed circulator will:


- Enhance existing transit service
- Reduce traffic congestion
- Provide reliable access to stadium, businesses, residences, shopping and more

Circulator will complement existing transit:

- Six routes in study area
 (10, 10A, 10B, 15, 20, 50)
- 50+ existing bus stops
- Cumberland Transfer Center
 Access to MARTA Route 12

COBB COUNTY | WINDY HILL - TERRELL MILL CONNECTOR

- Proposed connection between Windy Hill Road and Terrell Mill Road
 - Four-lane divided roadway
 - Would link with Interstate North Parkway/Spectrum Circle at Windy Hill and Bentley at Terrell Mill
- Alternate to Powers Ferry Road
- Desirable route with I-75 Managed Lanes project exit at Terrell Mill (2018)
- \$13 million local funding with \$12 million GDOT match and \$5 million right of way donation



COBB COUNTY | SKIP SPANN CONNECTOR

- Critical project for KSU and Town Center area
- Will construct a reliever bridge just north of Chastain Road to connect KSU campus to Town Park area
- Construction began April 2014
- Scheduled completion March 2016









COBB COUNTY | BlueTOAD


Travel time monitoring system

- Expanded pilot from 19 to 60 intersections
 - GDOT companion project monitors additional 43 intersections
- Congestion map will be made available via Cobb County webpage and NaviGAtor webpage
 - Soon available on mobile smart phone devices

Benefits

- To public:
 - Assists in choosing most advantageous routes
- To DOT:
 - Optimize traffic signal timing
 - Rapidly identify and respond to signal malfunctions
 - Quickly respond to traffic incidents

COBB COUNTY | AIRPORT INITIATIVES

New Air Traffic Control Tower

- Operations began March 5
- 78 feet tall
- Reduces glare, increases visibility and improves work environment

Customs Inspection Facility

- Opened June 25
- International flights can land in Cobb County
- Cobb County International Airport –
 McCollum Field

- Corporate Row hangar project
- Potential air charter services
- KSU academic program


- Focused on creating connections or "links"

- Launched March 23, 2015


10X Route
