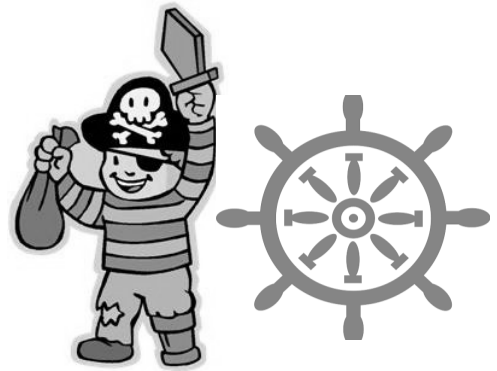


STEER CLEAR OF DRUGS! DON'T GET HOOKED!

The Red Ribbon Story: why we celebrate

The first nationwide Red Ribbon Campaign was organized and held in 1988 to commemorate the ultimate sacrifice made by DEA Agent, Enrique "Kiki" Camarena, who was killed by drug traffickers while on assignment in Mexico. Since that time, Red Ribbon Week has been celebrated every year to honor Camarena and all people who have died in the battle against the illegal drug trade. No other single drug prevention movement has had such an impact on so many lives.

We encourage students to lead healthy, drug free lives by making good choices. Our celebration week at school will include educational, charitable, and even some silly activities as a reminder that it is more fun to be drug free!
