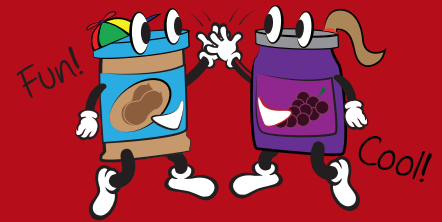
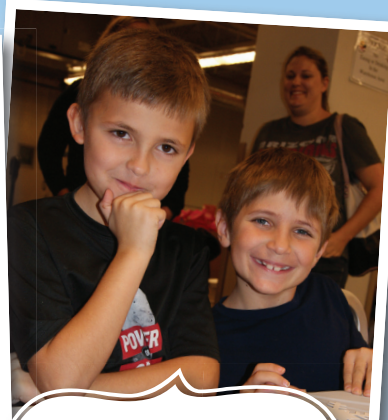

> CARSON AND CAPRICE ALWAYS HELP THE HUNGRY!

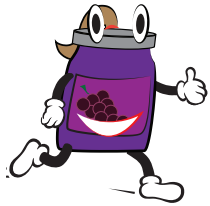

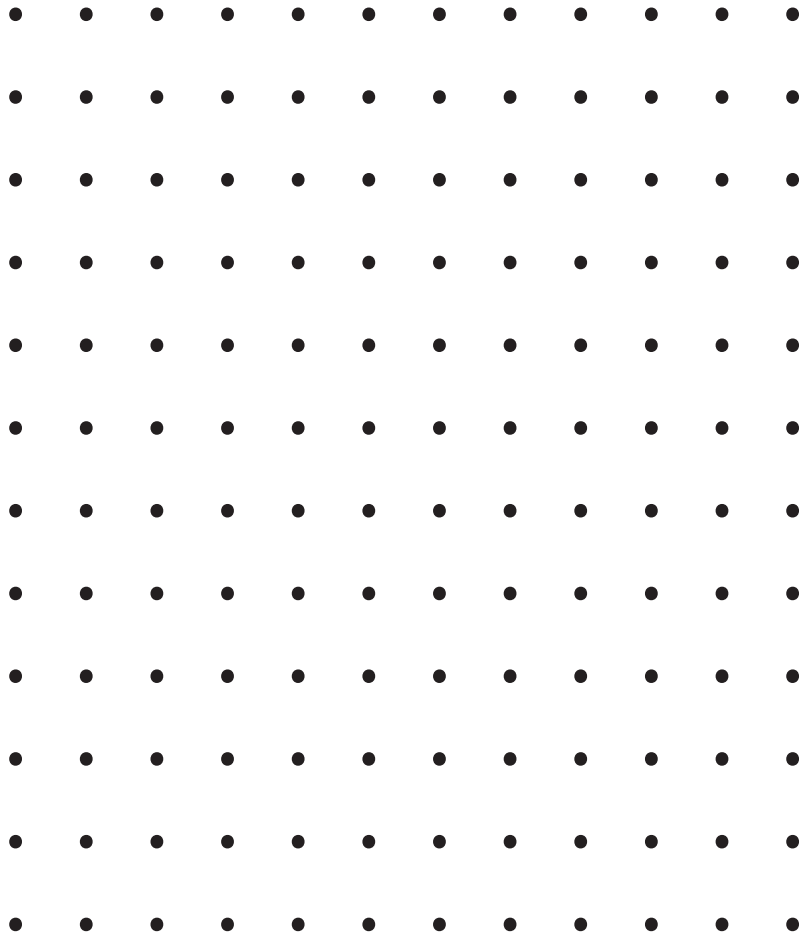
