Binding the Abortion Power

For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places. Eph. 6:12 (KJV)

As a casual student of the abolition of slavery movement, I have searched history for clues as to how to end abortion in America today. I was perplexed as to why the abolitionists talked so often about a "slave power". After research and prayer, I believe now they were not just referring to the "slaveocracy," the ruling class of slave owners, but were also referring to a spiritual, demonic power which was behind the slavery movement and the institution of slavery in the American South prior to the Civil War. Jesus said that He has given His church authority to bind and loose, "Truly I say to you, whatever you bind on earth shall have been bound in heaven; and whatever you loose on earth shall have been loosed in heaven." Matthew 18:18 (KJV) In addition, Jesus said unless you bind the strong man you cannot plunder his house. "But no one can enter the strong man's house and plunder his property unless he first binds the strong man, and then he will plunder his house." Mark 3:27. (KJV)

Linking these two scriptures together with the Great Commission (Math. 28:20), we see Jesus has all authority on earth, both spiritual and natural, but He has delegated some of this authority to His church. Therefore, I suggest that we need to begin to pray as a movement that the Lord would "bind the abortion power." You can ask the Lord to bind the abortion power in your particular city, state, over the media, the courts, legislatures, in Washington, D.C., over the United States, and the international level through various bodies like the United Nations. You can ask the Lord to bind the abortion power over the abortionists, abortion employees, and pro-abortion supporters such as NARAL. First bind the strong man. Here is a sample prayer:

Dear Lord,

We ask you in the Name of Jesus, and by His Blood and through His authority, that you would bind and rebuke the Abortion Power. It is written: "Greater is He who is in us than he who is in the world." It is

written that we do not wrestle against flesh and blood (the abortionists and pro-abortion supporters) but against powers, principalities, and forces of wickedness in the heavenly places.

Father, deliver us from this evil and from retaliation from the evil one, in Jesus' Name, Amen.

This can also be localized to bind the abortion power in your particular city, state, or nation.

Do be cautious about reviling angelic majesties. Jude warns us about this: "Yet Michael the archangel, when contending with the devil he disputed about the body of Moses, durst not bring against him a railing accusation, but said, The Lord rebuke thee." Jude, v. 9. (KJV) In the book of Zechariah, even the archangel Michael says, "The Lord rebuke you, Satan." Zech. 3:2.

Washington, D.C., Assembly to Mark 40th Anniversary of Abortion Decision

The countdown has begun. January 25, 2013, marks the 40th anniversary of the *Roe v. Wade* decision of the U.S. Supreme Court to legalize abortion in America. On that date a coalition of Christian leaders will convene a massive assembly on the National Mall in Washington, D.C., to pray for a national and global revival and the end of abortion.

Cry4Life is not an organization but a movement of Christians from many affiliations to cry out to God to end abortion. The coalition has issued "a global call to millions of women, men and youth around the world to gather in public arenas and court houses, to cry out to God for His deliverance," according to the website Cry4Life.info. Their efforts will augment the annual March For Life in Washington, D.C., which brought a record-setting 500,000 marchers past the Supreme Court in January 2012. Cry4Life now seeks to link the next rally globally with millions of other pro-life supporters.

Since the 1973 *Roe v. Wade* decision, the lives of more than 55 million unborn babies in the United States alone have been terminated through abortion. In recent decades over a billion additional abortions have taken place worldwide, an estimated 50 million each year. "Their innocent blood... cries out before the throne of God for a voice," say Cry4Life organizers. Abortion-related complications also kill and maim

thousands of women yearly.

In the United States, abortion kills more blacks than their proportion of the population. The Rev. Dr. Clenard H. Childress Jr. calls the practice "black genocide," and says "Abortion is the greatest deception that has plagued the black church since Lucifer himself."

Cry4Life has been endorsed by many leaders and organizations committed to ending abortion, including Intercessors For America, Aglow International, TheCall, Operation Outcry, Abortion Recovery International, Beth Israel Jewish Ministries, Pray California, and Dr. James Dobson.

The Cry4Life Mobilization Team hosts bi-weekly free conference calls (details posted on the website) and has issued suggestions on how to mobilize participation. The website also offers guidelines for groups desiring to host a regional "Prepare Gathering" prior to the January 25th assembly in Washington. D.C.
