Dr. Philip Padrid received his veterinary degree in 1985 from The NYS College of Veterinary Medicine at Cornell University. He then completed a small animal medicine and surgery internship at Santa Cruz Veterinary Hospital, followed by a Residency at the UC

Davis School of Veterinary Medicine. In 1990 he completed a fellowship on Pulmonary and Critical Care Medicine at UC Davis School of Medicine. During 1990-2000 Dr. Padrid was Associate Professor of Medicine, Immunology, Molecular Medicine at The University of Chicago Pritzker School of Medicine. He then joined VCA as Midwest Regional Medical Director. From 2003-2008 Dr. Padrid was a practicing veterinary partner (specialty practice) of Family Pet Animal Hospital in Chicago. Since 2008 Dr. Padrid has served as VCA Southwest Regional Medical Director. He is also an adjunct Associate Professor of Molecular Medicine, U of Chicago Pritzker School of Medicine and adjunct Associate Professor of Small Animal Medicine at OSU School of Veterinary Medicine.

Dr. Padrid's research at U of C focused on molecular mechanisms involved in human and feline asthma. He is author of over 80 manuscripts and book chapters on human and veterinary pulmonary medicine, including manuscripts published in the Journal of Immunology, British Journal of Pharmacology and American Journal of Respiratory and Critical Care Medicine, among others. He is a past author of Respiratory Medicine for the Vet Clinics of North America and is acknowledged to be the first person in our profession to actively promote and research the use of inhaled medications to treat veterinary patients with respiratory disease. He is "official vet" of the NPR-based radio station Dogtalktheradioshow and a frequent guest on the Sirius/XM radio talk show Catchat.
