Technology is making it even easier for individuals with hearing loss to stay connected. According to the Hearing Loss Association of America, about 20% or 48 million people report some degree of hearing loss. **CaptionCall**, a company based in Salt Lake City, Utah has developed a telephone which allows the user to follow conversation from their phone, using voice recognition technology and a transcription service that displays in text what the user on the other end is saying.

Under the Americans with Disabilities Act, service is provided free of charge to anyone who is deemed eligible. The only requirements needed to use this device are a high speed internet connection, home phone line, and a medically recognized hearing loss.
