Is your child with a disability between 15 - 18 years old and in need of transition guidance? Did you know once an individual reaches the age of eighteen, he is considered to be of the age of majority, is presumed to be competent under the law, and is permitted by law to act on his own behalf? Parents of children with disabilities who are unable to make decisions regarding their healthcare, education and finances will need to seek legal guidance as to what options to consider.

Loyola University College of Law now offers Continuing Tutorship

Parents filing for Continuing Tutorships for their children with disabilities now have a new option of places to go. Loyola University College of Law is now offering this service for parents that live in Orleans and Jefferson Parish. The Loyola Law Clinic does not charge attorney fees, however, the parents will need to pay for any court costs and/or recording fees. There is a financial eligibility which is 200% of the federal poverty guidelines. Financial eligibility will be discussed with the potential client during a telephone interview.
