New Opportunities for Students in Pre-Employment Transition Services – the promise of WIOA (Workforce Innovation and Opportunities Act). WIOA adds a new section to the Rehabilitation Act which requires each state to provide, or otherwise arrange for the provision of, pre-employment transition services for all eligible students with disabilities.

This includes: job exploration counseling; work-based learning experiences (e.g., in-school or after school opportunities including internships) in an integrated environment to the extent possible. To learn more for your high school child join us in the informational session.
