Keynote Speaker: Patti Martin, Ph.D. is the Director of Audiology and Speech-Language Pathology at Arkansas Children's Hospital and an Adjunct Assistant Professor of Audiology in the College of Health Professions at the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences. Her areas of expertise include newborn screening, pediatric assessment, family support, and program expansion. She was elected to two terms on the American-Speech-Language-Hearing Association Special Interest Division/Childhood Hearing Disorders steering committee and is a consultant for the Technical Assistance Network through NCHAM. Dr. Martin provides oversight and direction to a staff of over 100 and is involved in Au.D./ENT resident physician training and education through the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences. Furthermore, she is involved in multiple grant-funded projects and research centering on improving access, independence and outcomes for children with hearing loss. Her doctoral program emphasis was in Family and Disability Policy, reflecting her passion about the many ways that families impact outcomes of children who are deaf/hard of hearing.
