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Nurse Family Partnership



Nurse - Family Partnership is a program for women who are having their first baby. The goals of the programs are to 1) Improve pregnancy outcomes, 2) Improve child health

and development, and 3) Improve the economic self-sufficiency of the family. If you enroll, a registered nurse will visit you in your home throughout pregnancy and continue to visit until your baby is 2 years old. The program is FREE to all eligible women (determined by Medicaid eligibility, SNAP, WIC, TANF or SSI eligibility). The nurse will help the client have a healthy pregnancy and a healthy baby; become a better parent; build a strong network of support for client and her baby; make client's home a safe place for the baby to live and play; get referrals for healthcare, childcare, job training and other support services available in the community; find ways to continue her education and develop job skills; set goals for her family's future and find ways to help them reach those goals. Any woman who is **Pregnant with her first child, meets income requirements and lives in the service area (Orleans, St. Bernard, Jefferson, and Plaquemines Parish)** may enroll in the program.
