

State Propositions

50 **SUSPENSION OF LEGISLATORS. LEGISLATIVE CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT.** Authorizes Legislature to suspend Members, including without salary and benefits. Prohibits suspended Members from using powers of office or legislative resources. Provides suspension may end on specified date or by vote of Member's house. Fiscal Impact: No effect on state spending in most years. Minor state savings in some years.

School Bond Measure

J "To improve the quality of education, provide safe and modern schools for all students with funding that cannot be taken by the state; upgrade, modernize and construct classrooms, science labs and libraries; improve student access to technology; repair leaky roofs, outdated electrical and plumbing systems; and improve safety, security and access for students with disabilities shall Fairfield-Suisun Unified School District issue \$249,000,000 of bonds at legal rates, including independent citizens' oversight, audits and NO money for administrative salaries?"

County Measures

Y Should Ordinance 2016-01 be adopted? (If adopted, would enact a one-quarter of one percent sales tax for 10 years for general county purposes, such as correctional facilities for mental health/addiction treatment and job training for offenders to re-enter society as productive citizens; help fight the influence of gangs; reduce jail crowding to prevent early release of inmates; improve officer safety; support programs that improve the wellbeing of children; or other essential services within Napa County.)

AA **San Francisco Bay Clean Water, Pollution Prevention and Habitat Restoration Program.** To protect San Francisco Bay for future generations by reducing trash, pollution and harmful toxins, improving water quality, restoring habitat for fish, birds and wildlife, protecting communities from floods, and increasing shoreline public access, shall the San Francisco Bay Restoration Authority authorize a parcel tax of \$12 per year, raising approximately \$25 million annually for twenty years with independent citizen oversight, audits, and all funds staying local?

School Bond Measure

H "To fix or replace earthquake damage, fire safety, plumbing/mechanical systems with funding that cannot be taken by the State, relocate or repair schools on earthquake faults, update aging electrical, plumbing, outdated heating/ventilation systems, provide flexible classrooms/labs for science and other core academics, update classrooms for vocational/career technology, repair, construct, acquire classrooms, sites, facilities/equipment, shall Napa Valley Unified School District issue \$269,000,000 in bonds, at legal rates, with independent oversight/audits, no money for administrators?"

School Bond Measure

A To improve the quality of education with funding that cannot be taken by the state; modernize outdated classrooms, restrooms and school facilities; replace temporary portables with permanent classrooms; and construct a multi-purpose room for school and community use; shall the Pope Valley Union School District issue \$4,000,000 of bonds at legal interest rates, have an independent citizens' oversight committee, annual audits and NO money used for administrative or teacher salaries?
