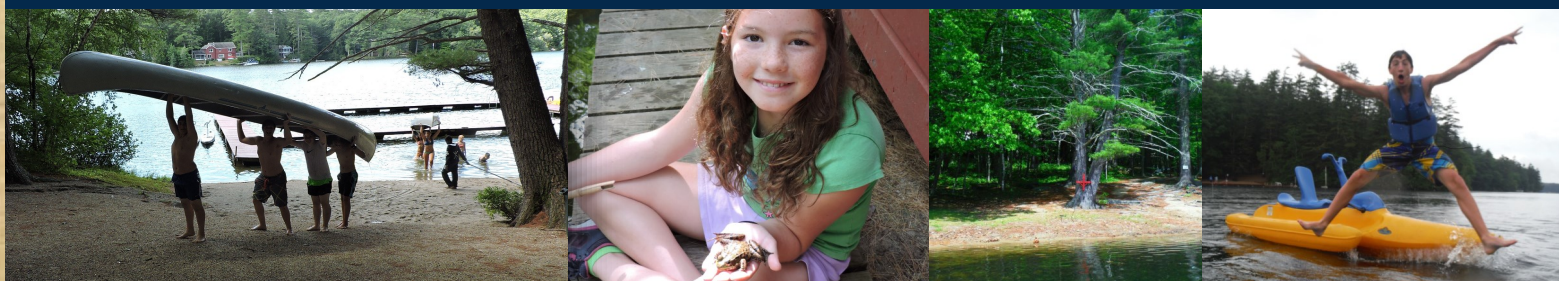

Camp Quinebarge is a traditional co-ed summer camp for kids ages 7 -15 where they actively learn, create, and have fun all summer long.

Founded in 1936, Quinebarge sits on over 65 acres of idyllic woodland and 1,250 feet of pristine Lake Kanasatka, in the heart of New Hampshire's mountains and Lakes Region.

Quinebarge encourages campers to challenge themselves and to try new activities in a safe and supportive setting with staff helping each child grow, learn, and achieve their goals. We foster a spirit of community, cooperation and respect for nature embedded into our rich tradition of camp life that includes outdoor activities, campfires, songs, skits, cabin life, and of course, fun!

Join the campers of Camp Quinebarge who have developed memories and friendships to last a lifetime, forged from our intentionally inclusive community for the past 80 summers.

Camper Program

Campers are active all day at Camp Quinebarge with over 20 daily activities that include both scheduled and elective options. Our waterfront program, conducted according to the American Red Cross standards, offers daily swim instruction along with sailing, canoeing, kayaking, surf-biking and paddle boarding. A full range of sports is offered, from field and court sports to archery, climbing wall, and fun on the high ropes course and zip line.

In our Nature and Environment program, campers learn to respect the Earth through hands-on activities as well as guided walks through our extensive system of nature trails. Our popular horseback riding program includes lessons from qualified instructors in both ring, trail riding, and horse care. Quinebarge is pleased to offer both horses and ponies to accommodate all levels of rider abilities.

Quinebarge's popular crafts program features woodworking, pottery, and painting as well as traditional and eco-oriented arts and crafts activities.

Camp also provides a robust trips program of hiking, canoeing, overnights, cabin excursions and weekly all-camp trips. Thoughtfully and safely designed to meet the developing skills of each camper's age group, the trips program offers special hikes and overnights that become more challenging and more rewarding as each camper progresses through Camp Quinebarge. Evening activities involve all-camp activities such as capture the flag, camp fires, skit night, and socials in addition to specially designed, unique cabin activities to encourage campers to bond.

Quinebarge offers a fun-filled and bustling schedule that keeps campers actively engaged all summer long.

Cabin Life

Cabin life at Quinebarge enables campers to make friends and bond as a group, live with their peers, experience some independence and enjoy living in a rustic setting surrounded by the wonders and beauty of nature. Campers are responsible for keeping their beds, cubbies, and personal areas tidy, and for working together to clean their cabin, clothesline, and grounds around the cabin. As part of the camp tradition, each day, one camper per cabin helps serve the meals to their bunk mates as a waiter/waitress in the dining hall.

Campers sleep in their cabins, where they also spend rest periods after lunch and have quality time with bunk mates during cabin specific evening activities. In the cabin, where the magic of camp really starts, they have time to read, play games, bond over discussions, and develop a group identity. With a remarkably low camper-to-staff ratio of just 3-to-1, there is always a counselor available.

Our most important goal at Camp Quinebarge is to foster a nurturing environment for all children, where they can grow as individuals and as a group.

Camp Fires, Monkeytown and more ...

Quinebarge offers both the myriad traditional camp experiences and some found only at our special summer home. Camp fires are a staple of camp, with weekly fires overlooking the lake at Piney Point, where we have singing, skits and stories, and of course, s'mores. Group areas and cabins also have their own camp fires and cook outs, where campers learn how to safely make, maintain, and extinguish camp fires.

Another unique aspect of Camp Quinebarge is the wonderful and camp favorite, Monkeytown. For over seventy years, Monkeytown, with its own mayor, money, Olympics and Carnivals, serves as a focal point for camp life not seen elsewhere. Cabins work together to decorate their piece of Monkeytown, and offer concessions and games for campers to play at the carnivals.

The entire Quinebarge experiences harkens back to a time of kids being kids, without the distractions of modern life, exploring the natural world around them, developing friendships that will last forever, telling stories, singing songs and playing games in a safe, fun and nurturing environment.
