- **LIBRARY BOARD MEETING** — Seven Trustees are each elected for a 5-year term by voting residents of the Cornwall Central School District. Meetings are open to the public. The meetings are generally on the 2nd Tuesday of the month at 7:00 p.m. unless otherwise noted.
- **1ST WEDNESDAY BOOK GROUP** — Discuss a fiction novel, contemporary or classic, with fellow participants —generally on the 1st Wednesday of each month at 7:00 p.m. unless a holiday falls on that date.
