"It opened my mind to a new possible career, I learned something new, I learned about apprenticeships and internships and how to get them."








Did the communication and planning prior to the visit adequately prepare you?










"Many said they liked something more than they thought they would or they were able to realize that a certain career might not be for them and were able to identify something that was better suited to their liking.."




How would you characterize how prepared the business was for your visit?



"The site visit was beneficial to me because it provided me information that I could pass along to my students who did not attend the visit. There was information about programs that may be available for students who did not attend the site visit."











Do you see relevance between the site visited and student coursework?

■Not Enough ■Just Right ■Too Much




