JUROR: Carl Purcell

Carl Purcell taught painting and drawing at Snow College in Utah for 30 years. He is currently retired from the college but is a popular painting and drawing workshop instructor, having conducted workshops throughout the West, from Alaska to Arizona, and in Great Britain.

Carl is the author of the North Light publications, Painting With Your Artist's Brain (a watercolor book) and Drawing With Your Artist's Brain. In addition his art has been featured in numerous articles published in The Artist's Magazine and in Splash I. He has been invited to jury exhibits in Colorado, New Mexico, Wyoming, Utah, Nevada, Michigan and Califonia.

Carl has achieved signature member status in the National Watercolor Society and was given honor member status in the Utah Watercolor Society for his contributions to watercolor in the state. He has won numerous awards, including a purchase award in the 2008 National Watercolor Society's international exhibition. PLEASE NOTE:

- Participants are limited to a total of three (3) entries. All paintings must be original conceived and created by you. No work produced under instruction or in a workshop, or copies of another's work or of copyrighted references will be accepted. Work using photographs other than the artist's own is not considered original.
- Paintings must have been completed within the last two years, and not have previously been exhibited in a juried exhibit sponsored by the Utah Watercolor Society. All works must be on natural or synthetic paper or paperboard, rendered in water media and unvarnished. No clay board or canvas. No water based oils. A work that is primarily collage must use water media paper painted by the artist. A work that is mixed media/collage must use at least 75% water-based media in conjunction with other media, such as pastel, ink, crayon, printed collage papers, found papers, etc. These "other media" may not be the dominant element. No digital art will be accepted.
- Work selected for the exhibition must remain for the duration of the show.
- By entering this show you grant permission to use your artwork image in publicity.
- A commission of 40% will be deducted from all sales by Logan Fine Art Gallery. By entering this show, the artist enters into contract with the gallery, which will be the acting agent for the sale of their artwork. Artists may also enter work that is not for sale.
- Work image must be no more than 22 x 30 inches (mat and frame not included).
- Framing: Paintings must be ready to hang with wire supports. Paintings may be floated on a mat or matted in the traditional way. For this show, mats must me white or off-white; colored liner is acceptable. Please use stable backing material. Plexiglas is appreciated for larger paintings, but is not required.
- While utmost care will be taken in handling entries and artwork, neither UWS-CVC nor its representative will be responsible for damage or loss from any cause.
