All classes held at Cienega High School

Dates:

- 1st semester May 31 –June 3, June 6-9 & June 13-14
2nd semester June 16-17, June 20-23 & June 27-30
- 1st semester classes (ending in “A”) may only be taken in the 1st semester of summer school, and 2nd semester classes (ending in “B”) only in the 2nd semester of summer school (for in-person classes only).
- Registration for 1st semester is due on May 16th. 2nd semester must be turned in by May 20th (add \$10 for late registration).
- Students who are completing a core credit during summer school must take the corresponding AZ Merit exam for their course during the last day(s) of the class in order to receive credit.

Cost:

- \$175.00 per semester. Make checks payable to Vail School District. (\$25 fee assessed on returned check.)
- Scholarships are available in extreme circumstances. You must contact your school administrator by May 16th for approval.
- Please bring your own lunch. The cafeteria will not be available.

- Students will be dropped from class after accumulating 1.5 days of absences, excused or unexcused.
- Any/all discipline problems are grounds for immediate dismissal with no refund. (i.e. two absences, fighting, insubordination, illegal substances, disruptive behavior, etc.)
- Busing will be provided, but on different routes than the regular school year. Contact your school’s front office for a copy of Summer School bus routes.
- Summer School grades will be on your official high school transcripts.
- Enrollment must reach 15 students or classes may be canceled. Classes are capped once they reach 25 students.
- Students are not allowed to leave campus for lunch and must have written approval from guardian to leave early for any reason.
