

# **EDL 690: International Perspectives on Student Affairs - Europe**

## May 19 to June 3, 2016

3 credits

Internationalize your understanding of student affairs by traveling to Central Europe to explore the organization and provision of higher education and student affairs in three European countries – Germany, the Czech Republic and Poland. Over a two-week period participants will visit universities in Berlin, Dresden, Prague and Krakow meeting with and learning from faculty, staff and university students. Additionally the study abroad curriculum includes guided tours of important cultural sites such as the Berlin Wall, Holocaust Memorial, and the Brandenburg Gate in Berlin; St. Vitus Cathedral, Prague Castle, Charles Bridge and the Jewish Quarter in Prague; Main Market Square,

Schindler's Factory Museum in Krakow and Auschwitz-Birkenau concentration camps.

# **Program Highlights:**

- Visit two of Europe's most prestigious universities dating from the middle ages Charles University in Prague, (1248); and Jagiellonian University in Krakow, (1400).
- In Dresden learn about the German ministry for student services, Deutsches Studentenwerk.
- Discover the significant role of the of the European Student Union in representing student voice in Europe
- Trace Jewish culture in Prague and Krakow; the history of the Holocaust in Berlin and Auschwitz.
- Marvel at the beauty of two of Europe's most magnificent old towns squares in Prague and Krakow
- Free time in each of these stunning European cities to explore on your own
