This hands-on workshop offers an introduction to the preservation of photographs, including their identification, deterioration, and care. Participants will learn how to recognize various photographic formats and study the preservation problems associated with each format type. The workshop will also discuss storage concerns and preservation priorities, including environmental guidelines and proper care and handling. Participants are encouraged to bring photographs for examination and discussion.

This workshop is designed for local historical societies and small museums and libraries, as well as individuals who are looking to gain knowledge about how to preserve a variety of photographic materials. The workshop is being offered twice on November 7, giving participants their choice of a morning or afternoon session.

About our Presenter: Monique C. Fisher is the senior photograph conservator at the Northeast Document Conservation Center. She holds a bachelor's degree in chemistry from Smith College and master's degree in art conservation from the University of Delaware/Winterthur Museum. Monique lectures extensively on photograph conservation and has taught seminars on photograph preservation in the United States and abroad. She is a Fellow of the American Institute for Conservation of Historic and Artistic Works.
