Pool Rules 2015

Opening Day May 23, 2015 at noon

Closing Day Sept. 20, 2015

Pool Hours:

May: Monday - Sunday 11 a.m. to 8 p.m.

June: Monday - Sunday 11 a.m. to 8 p.m.

July: Monday - Sunday 11 a.m. to 9 p.m.

Aug.: Monday - Sunday 11 a.m. to 8 p.m.

Sept.: Monday - Sunday 11 a.m. to 8 p.m.

Pool may be closed due to inclement weather at the sole discretion of the lifeguards, for swim meets and other member events.

Pool Rules

1. No horseplay allowed (pushing, dunking etc.)
2. No running on the deck
3. No glass containers
4. No hanging on the lane/pool divider lines
5. No unsafe conduct allowed
6. Obey the life guards at all times
7. No conversations with the guards while they are on the stands
8. No flotation devices in the deep end
9. No smoking
10. No alcohol or drinks in glass containers
11. No one under the age of 12 allowed without a supervising adult at any time.
12. Parents are responsible for the behavior of their children at all times

Diving Well Rules

1. Only one person on the board at a time; wait on the deck for your turn
2. Only one bounce allowed
3. Swim directly to the ladder after going off the board
4. No swimming in the deep end
5. No bouncing while facing backwards on the board
6. Do not hang on the board
7. Do not swim under the board

Baby Pool

1. No lifeguard is provided for the baby pool
2. Parents are responsible for children using the baby pool
3. The baby pool is for use by children 5 years old and younger
4. Children who are not potty trained must wear a swim diaper or tight fitting plastic pants

Children's Play Area

1. Play equipment is for use of children 5 and under only
2. Parents are responsible for supervising their children at all times

Sign In

1. Members are required to sign in upon entering pool area each visit
2. Members over the age of 12 not accompanied by an adult must provide photo ID
3. Residents must identify and sign in any guests at time of sign in

Guests

1. Heritage Greens Swim and Tennis Club is for the exclusive use of members and their invited guests.
2. Members are limited to 2 guests per visit
3. Members Households are limited to 5 total guests per visit.
4. If you suspect unauthorized entry to the pool area by a non-member, please bring it to the attention of the head lifeguard immediately.

Pool Regulations

1. The lifeguards have complete control over all activities in the pool area at all times. Their instructions must be obeyed.
2. Unsafe behavior could result in the offending party being asked to leave the premises for the rest of the day. Facility privileges may be suspended for up to 48 hours by the lifeguards and longer periods by the Aquatics Director or Board of Directors for infractions of either the pool rules and/or regulations.
3. No person with an infectious or communicable disease or open wound is permitted in the pool area.
4. Flotation devices are allowed in the pool, but not the deep end. They must not be detrimental to overall safety.
5. Children who cannot swim the length of the pool, infants and toddlers must be in direct contact of their supervising adult when in the pool. This means within arms reach.
6. Children 12 and under must be accompanied by a supervising adult when in the pool area.
7. During regular pool hours, the pool will be cleared at 50 minutes past the hour for adult swim for 10 minutes. No one under 18 will be allowed to swim at this time. However, an adult may take one child under the age of 5 with them, as long as they maintain direct contact with the child.
8. Animals are not allowed in the pool area at any time, nor are you allowed to tie them off outside the pool area and then use the facility.
9. Proper swim attire is required in the pool area at all times. Members are responsible for any property damage caused by their families and their guests. Members are also responsible for the behavior of their guests while on the clubs' premises.

10. Baby sitter rule: A non-swimming child must be with a responsible adult at all times in the pool area. A non-swimming child is one who has not passed the swimming test. This test consists of swimming one length of the pool with out stopping. If the lifeguard determines the supervising adult is not supervising the child satisfactorily, both will be asked to leave for the remainder of the day.
11. Radios and other electronic devices playing music are to be kept at a low enough volume so as not to disturb other people using the facility. The lifeguard will determine acceptable volume levels. Failure to comply will result in turning the device off.
12. Bicycles, skateboards, roller blades, scooters etc. are not allowed in the pool or tennis areas of the club. Any damage caused by individuals using them in these areas is the responsibility of the member.
13. Bicycles are to be parked in the bike rack or on the grass. They are not to be left in front of the access way to the facility. Access must not be blocked in case emergency in case personnel need to assist a member or answer an emergency.
14. For the safety and comfort of the members NO GLASS is ever allowed in the pool area
15. For the safety and comfort of the members NO SMOKING is ever allowed on the premises.
16. The guardroom is for exclusive use of the guards. No members are allowed in this area unless attending to an emergency. The lifeguards are here to provide a safe environment for the pool area, specifically those members in the water. They are not baby sitters or your mothers, so please pick up after yourself. Please place any trash, especially food items in the proper receptacle. We want the gem of our neighborhood to look as nice as possible at all times. Please take pride in its appearance!
