CLOUDY BAY, 2014 SAUVIGNON BLANC,
MARLBOROUGH, NEW ZEALAND Appealing concentration
and poise suggests a wine with the ability to age. The nose is bright with
aromas of kaffir lime and grapefruit. A generous palate reveals ripe
citrus, stone fruit and lemongrass flavors balanced by crunchy acidity.
Perhaps the hallmark of this vintage is its persistent finish rich with
minerality.

SKYFALL VINEYARD, 2013 PINOT GRIS, COLUMBIA VALLEY, WASHINGTON Pale straw in color with notes of mango, citrus blossom and banana in the nose. On the palate a medley of tropical fruit unfolds into tangerine, mango, grapefruit, and banana flavors. These tropical notes continue throughout the long and lingering finish.

SAKONNET VINEYARD, 2012 VIDAL BLANC, LITTLE COMPTON, RHODE ISLAND Showcasing flavors and aromas of lime, grapefruit, and pear. Crisp and medium bodied, it pairs well with summer salads and seafood.
