Woodbadge for the 21st Century

This 6 day leadership development course is the most advanced leader training offered at the Council Level. The course is built on the aims and methods of Boy Scouts including developing leadership through the patrol method and challenges. Each participant will improve his or her ability to identify goals, plan, guide others and communicate effectively. These skills pay off in Scouting as well as in professional and personal life. For all Cub Scout, Boy Scout or Venturing Leaders who are trained for their position.

Boy Scout (& Webelos) Leader Training

Boy Scout Leader Specific Training

An overview of methods and leadership skills used by Scoutmasters and Assistant Scoutmasters to guide a youth-led troop. Topics include the Aims and Methods of Scouting, The Patrol Method, Advancement and the Troop Support Team. This training is required for Scoutmasters & Assistant Scoutmasters and recommended for Webelos leaders and Troop Committee members.

Introduction to Outdoor Leadership Skills

In this overnight course, Scoutmasters, Assistant Scoutmasters and other Scout leaders learn how to deliver an effective, fun and safe outdoor experience for their units. Topics include planning, campsite selection, first aid, cooking, equipment, safe use of axes and other tools, outdoor advancement, map and compass and more. Required for Scoutmaster and Assistant Scoutmaster and recommended for Webelos and Troop Committee.

Troop Committee Challenge

While this required course can be completed online, we recommend Troop Committees come together and complete the workshop as a group. Members will develop a deeper understanding the aims of Scouting and their role in supporting an effective Troop. Topics include planning, budget, fundraising and more.

Cub Scout Leader Training

Cub Scout Leaders – Get Trained Online or at Roundtable

All Cub Scout Leadership positions have specific required training which can be completed Online at myscouting.org. This includes Cubmaster/Assistant Cubmasters, Den Leaders, Pack Committee Members and Parent Coordinators and Pack Trainers. In addition, live sessions are offered occasionally, including at Round Tables (check the training schedule at <http://www.hmc-bsa.org/training>) or at the University of Scouting (March 12, 2016).

Baloo – Basic Adult Leadership Outdoor Orientation

All Cub Scout leaders and parents can participate in this day long course aimed at the skills needed to provide a fun and safe outdoor experience for Cub Scout Packs. Leaders learn how to plan an overnight experience, lead fun games and hikes, cook outdoors, select equipment and how to keep the Pack safe while in the outdoors. At least one overnight event leader must be Baloo trained – and we strongly recommend at least 2 Baloo trained adults on every camp-out.
