Richard Rudnick was raised in Worcester, earned his undergraduate degree from Swarthmore College and his MD from Boston University. After 25 years of practicing medicine in the greater Worcester community, Richard left his practice to further his Jewish education. He completed his training at the Rabbinical School of Hebrew College and currently serves Jewish Healthcare Center, Inc., as campus rabbi and chaplain. He also serves as Jewish chaplain at UMass Memorial Medical Center. Richard's community involvement began in high school as an officer of Temple Emanuel's youth group. He went on to serve on their board of directors. In addition, Richard has served and held leadership positions on the boards of Worcester Jewish Community Housing for the Elderly, Solomon Schechter Day School, the New Jewish Academy, Jewish Federation of Central Massachusetts, and Congregation Beth Israel.

<u>Sheila Trugman</u> earned her undergraduate degree from Brandeis University and received her MD from Boston University. After post-graduate training in Chicago and San Francisco, Sheila set up practice with her husband Richard.
