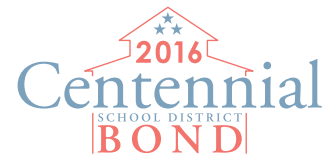


THE 2016 PROPOSED BOND WILL:

REPAIR & UPGRADE OUR SCHOOLS

This work includes key investments like new **roofs, building repairs and HVAC systems** that prolong building lives and saves taxpayer monies in energy efficiencies.

REDUCE OVERCROWDING

Enrollments are up across Centennial and with the addition of state mandated full-day kindergarten, our classrooms are bursting at the seams. This bond addresses overcrowding by **building a new middle school** on existing school property as well as **expanded multi-use rooms in 5 existing schools**.

INCREASE SAFETY & SECURITY

Unfortunately, the new normal means we must provide extra focus on school safety. This bond will pay for new **intercom systems, cameras, secured entries and automatic door locks**.

MODERNIZE OUR CLASSROOMS

Our children need a 21st learning environment to succeed and this bond provides **upgraded internet and networking, multiple outlets in every classroom** and modern electrical service.

THE COST

 **\$85 million dollars**
• \$1.31 per every \$1,000 of assessed value

What does that mean for you?

- For a \$150,000 home, the net increase in taxes will be \$197 per year, or \$16.38 per month or 54 cents a day.
- For a \$200,000 home, the net increase in taxes will be \$262 per year, or \$21.83 per month or 72 cents a day.
