

It has been only three months since Terry died, suddenly changing my world forever. Fortunately, over the years, Terry and I had discussed our individual plans if we were to be separated by death. Without hesitation each expressed the intent to remain in Morristown based on one overwhelming factor, namely, that parishioners of All Saints' are our family. Nowhere else do we fell as comfortable and supported. The last three months have confirmed the wisdom of our decision. Moving from a back rehabilitation facility to an assisted living facility while planning a major clean-up of our condo prior to putting it on the market all seemed overwhelming from the perspective of a wheelchair. All of those concerns we overcame by more than two dozen parishioners of All Saints' under the leadership and planning of the Pastoral Care Committee headed by Louise Joyce and able assistant, Taryn Herzog.

Nothing was overlooked in all facets of cleaning, revamping and modification of the condo so that it now looks absolutely new.

As Pastor Scherry mentioned in her May Saint Alive message, naming the parishioners individually would be impossible without error. So the best I can do is say a very heartfelt "THANK YOU!"

One additional note: I realize that I have dealt with only my problems here. My riginal intent was to recognize that every day parishioners from All Saint' demonstrate love, caring and many other Christian virtues without recognition. We are blessed to be in your company. God bless each of you.
