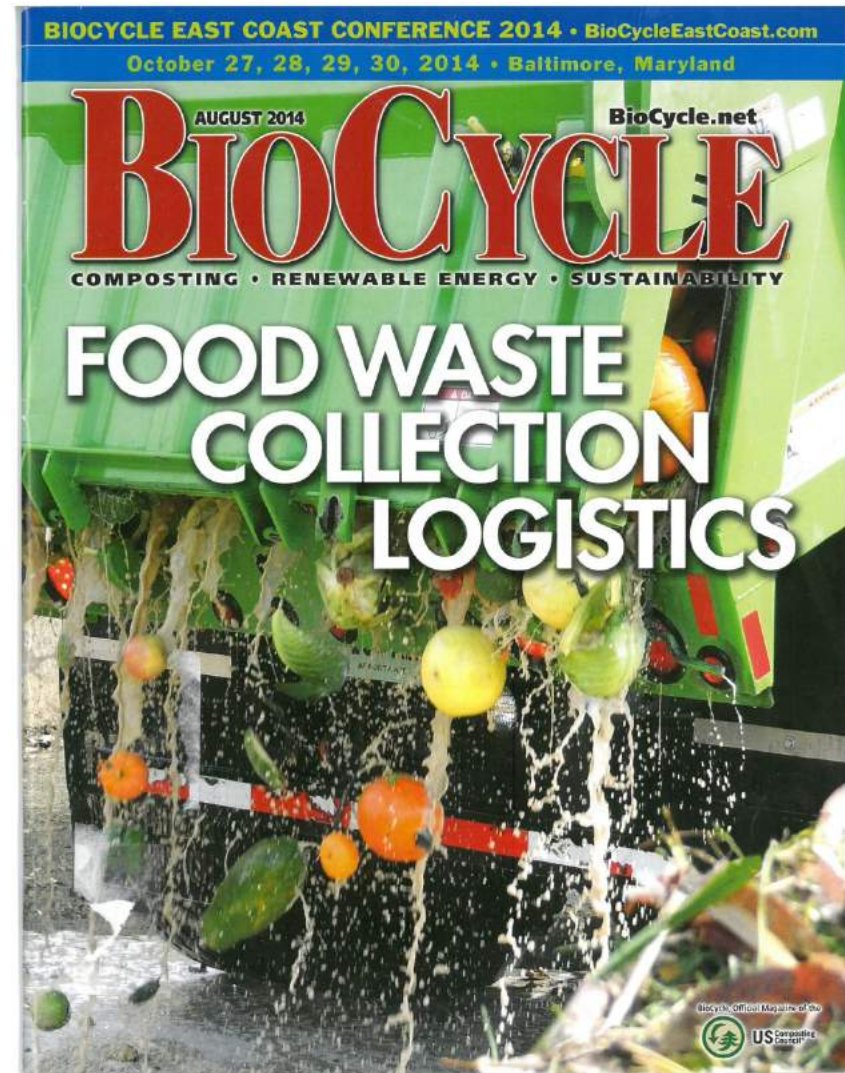
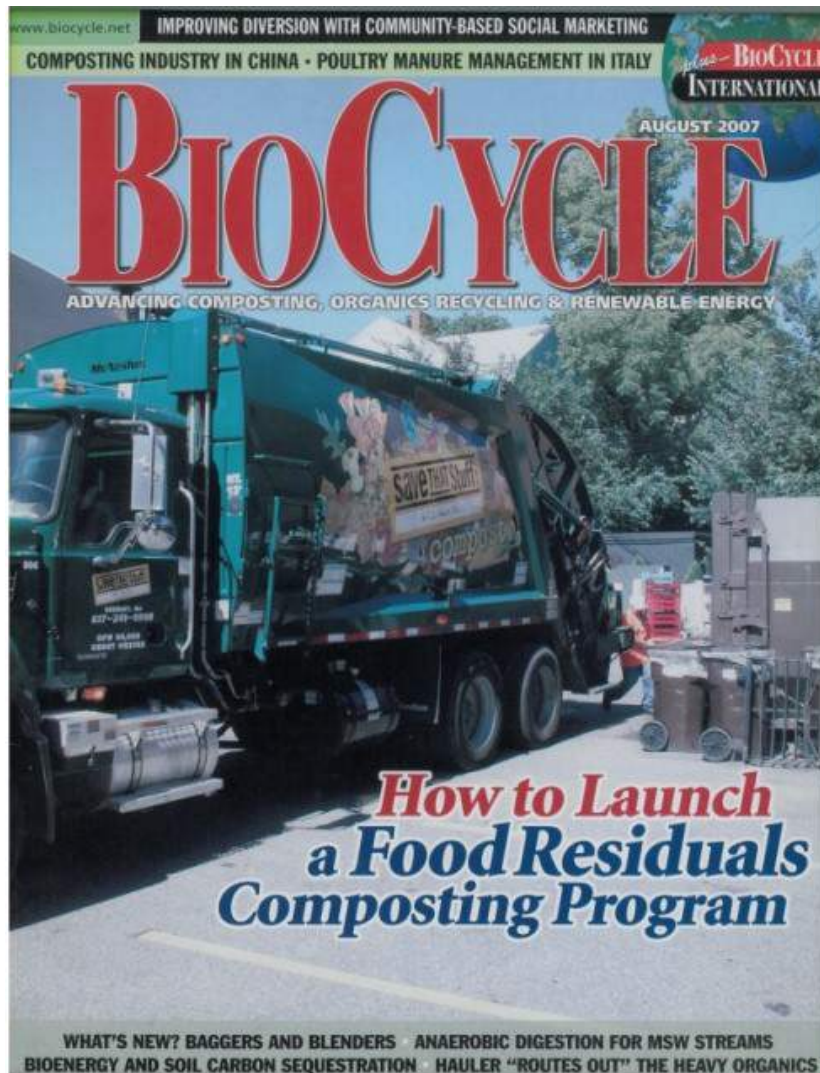

Ban Specifics

- Took effect October 1, 2014
- Food waste and vegetative material
- Doesn't apply to wastewater management
- Commercial/institutional generators who dispose of more than 1 ton a week
- Enforcement warnings have started with compactors

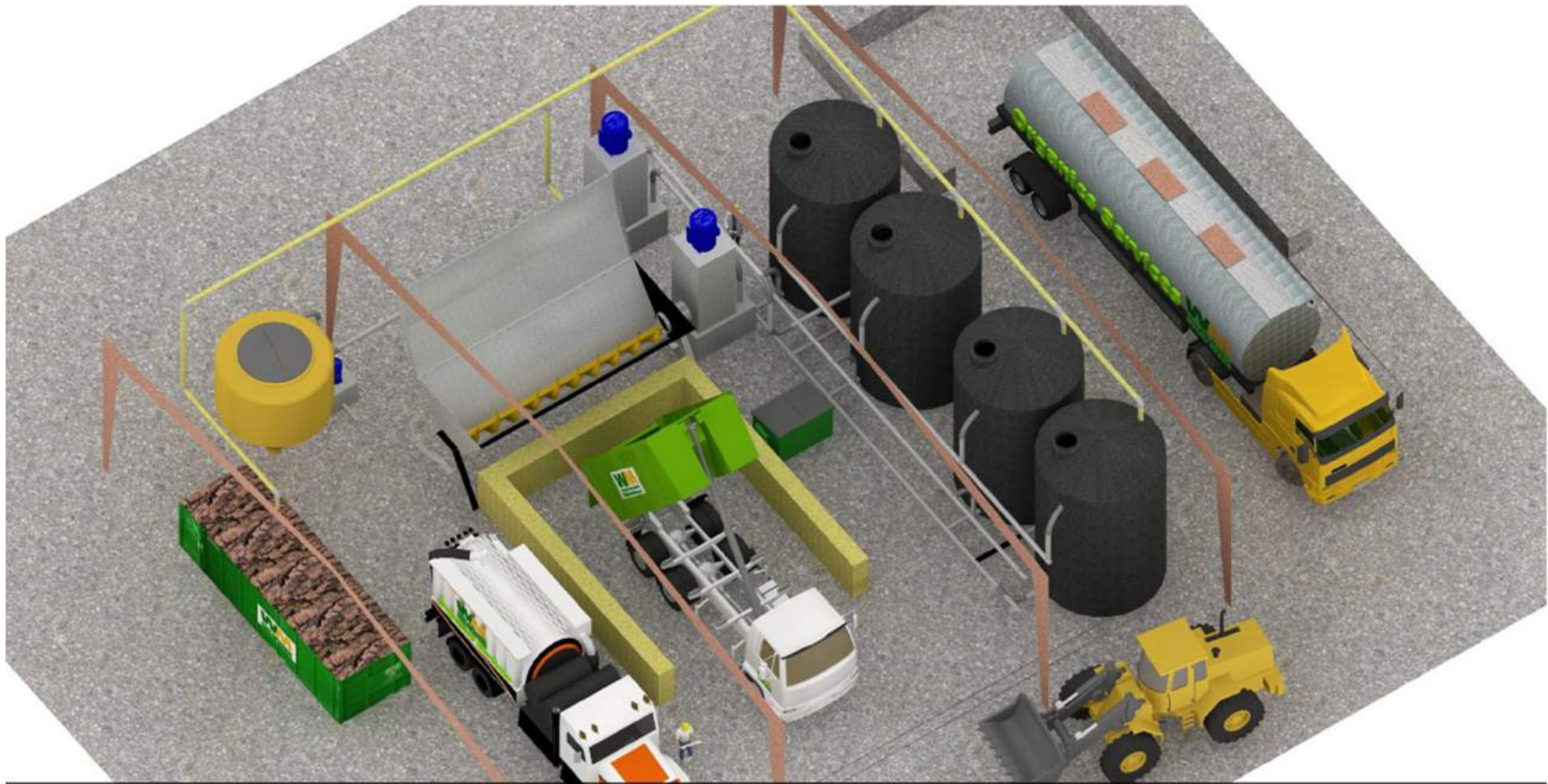
