- 1. Jumper class sizes are limited to 15 competitors per class with six ribbons given for each class. Approximate class start times will be posted on our website the Wednesday before the show. Riders can register for jumper classes the day of the show provided there are spaces available in that level.
- 2. Approved safety helmets and footwear mandatory. Safety vests are optional. Attire should be neat.
- 3. Fix-A-Test entries received after the closing date may be ineligible to participate depending on number of entries. No refunds will be given after the closing date unless the show is cancelled. There is a \$35 fee for each returned check.

4. Gates open at 3:00 P.M. Fix-a-Test warm-ups are in the small outdoor arena. Classes will be ridden in the indoor arena. Warm-ups for the jumper show will be ridden in the green grass next to the ring and classes are ridden on a $100' \times 200'$ stadium jumper course with all-weather footing consisting of a base of 6-inches of stone dust with 3- inches of sand mixed thoroughly among the stone dust.

Please call if bringing large trailer. No dogs allowed. We are a non-smoking facility which includes the trailer grounds, warm-up field, stable, and arena. Spectators please sit in spectator area only and please bring chairs.

- 6. Shows are on rain or shine. Only in extreme weather will a show be cancelled. Please call 301.788.1188 or check the website: www.playlandequestriancenter.com for more information.
