MOUNTAIN GORILLA & MIGRATION SAFARI

Your tour escort is **Jodi Carrigan**, Primate Keeper at Zoo Atlanta where she has been working with gorillas for over 10 years. Zoo Atlanta has one of the largest captive gorilla populations in the world. Jodi received her Bachelor's degree in Anthropology with a special interest in Primatology in 2001 from Indiana University of Pennsylvania. Jodi has visited Rwanda four times and looks forward to sharing her knowledge and love for these magnificent animals and for Rwanda with you.

Day 1 ~ February 10, 2015: Depart U.S.

Day 2 ~ February 11: Kigali, Rwanda

Arrive at Kigali airport, meet and greet, then transfer to your hotel for dinner and overnight.

Kigali Serena Hotel

The five-star Kigali Serena Hotel is built around a polished granite atrium, which showcases the very best of Rwandese cultural art. Relaxed yet elegant, the hotel centers on the Executive Lounge and Bar, which opens onto a wide sun deck overlooking the newly refurbished swimming pool. Also overlooking the pool, the popular Milima Restaurant offers a wide range of all-day buffet choices, while the relaxed Sokoni Café offers inside and outside poolside seating.

Day 3 ~ February 12: Volcanoes National Park

After breakfast, drive to Kinigi via Ruhengeri. The road to Ruhengeri is sealed offering stunning scenery of the hills and valleys of this green and lush country, taking a little more than 2 hours. From Ruhengeri we have a 20 minute drive to Kinigi at the base of Sabyinyo Mountain, with excellent views of all of the Virunga Volcanoes.

Overnight at Mountain Gorilla View Lodge – Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner



Mountain Gorilla View Lodge

Located 15km from Musanze (Ruhengeri) and 100km from Kigali with spectacular views of the volcanoes that make up the Virungas Range is Mountain Gorilla View Lodge. Experience the quiet and tranquility of nature where you are only 2-3km from the world famous and endangered Mountain Gorillas. MGVL has thirty-two chalets furnished with your comfort in mind. After a day visiting the Mountain Gorillas in Virunga National Park, the warmth of your personal fireplace awaits you.

Day 4-6 ~ February 13-15: Gorilla Tracking/Golden Monkey Trek/Hiking

Over the next three days you will have option to track gorillas and/or golden monkeys and/or visit the Iby' Iwachu village (see reservation form). Additionally, you will take a tour of the Karisoke Research Center, the world's centerpiece for the study and protection of the critically endangered mountain gorillas. The center was founded over 40 years ago by Dr. Dian Fossey and operated since her death by the Dian Fossey Gorilla Fund International. Today, Karisoke is the greatest hope for the future of the mountain gorilla, and has become a significant resource for the people who live near the gorillas. Enjoy a talk from one of the staff of the Dian Fossey Gorilla Fund.

Gorilla Tracking

After breakfast we take a short drive to Park Headquarters and meet with excellent local guides and trackers who will give a talk on the etiquette of gorilla trekking. We then hike into the forest to where the gorillas were seen the night before and track from that point. The trekking can take from 1 to 6 hours and climb to altitudes not in excess of 7,500 feet. The terrain is rough and at times muddy. Although the hike is physically demanding the beauty of the forest and surrounding scenery make the trekking worthwhile. Once the gorillas are located all fatigue is forgotten, as the experience is often described as being the most profound natural history experience in the world. Picnic lunches are provided and it is important to take plenty of water. Cameras and plenty of fast speed film are recommended. It can rain in a few minutes notice; hence waterproof clothing is a good essential including a waterproof bag for cameras and film. Please note: plastic (e.g. carrier / shopping) bags are illegal in Rwanda.

Golden Monkey Tracking

Enjoy a guided walk to observe a fully habituated group of rare Golden Monkeys. This is a completely different experience from gorilla tracking, as the monkeys are smaller, nimbler and may be harder to locate and follow. However, this is still an opportunity for a superb quality sighting of a rare and brightly colored monkey. Although there may be another group somewhere in the Nyungwe Forest, this is believed to be the only viable population.

Iby' Iwachu Cultural Village

Located just 10 minutes from your lodge, the Iby' Iwachu Cultural Village gives you the rare chance to meet and interact with local people, in their environment with a taste of Rwandese culture and traditions. Activities include:

- Visit a replica of the King's palace guided by local historical and cultural guides.
- Visit traditional healers to learn about the different medicinal trees, shrubs, and grasses and their uses and the way they are administered to the patient.
- Visit local schools.
- Explore a local banana brewery and see how the local beer is made and have a taste.
- Gather around the igitaramo, a camp fire, to listen to stories and riddles and also dance to the drum beats. Intore and Ekinimba dancers can perform eight different dances - Ibyivugo, Umuduri, Ikembe, Iningiri, Inanga, Ingoma, Amakndera, Agakenke.
- Join food gatherers in the harvesting and preparation of food like ubugari, umutsima, ibirayi, and igikoma. Guests can also participate in millet grinding with stones and see whether they have enough balance to carry potatoes and water on their heads.
- Visit homes and farms and experience the rural Rwandan ways of living in a 3-hour walk through Nyabigoma village.

Overnight at Mountain Gorilla View Lodge – Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner

Day 7 ~ February 16: Kigali City Tour & Transfer to Tanzania

Return to Kigali for a half day city tour, including the genocide museum and memorial and lunch. You will then be transferred to the airport for your flight to Tanzania. Upon arrival to Kilimanjaro International Airport you will be transferred for dinner and your overnight to **[Mt. Meru Game Lodge](#) - Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner.**



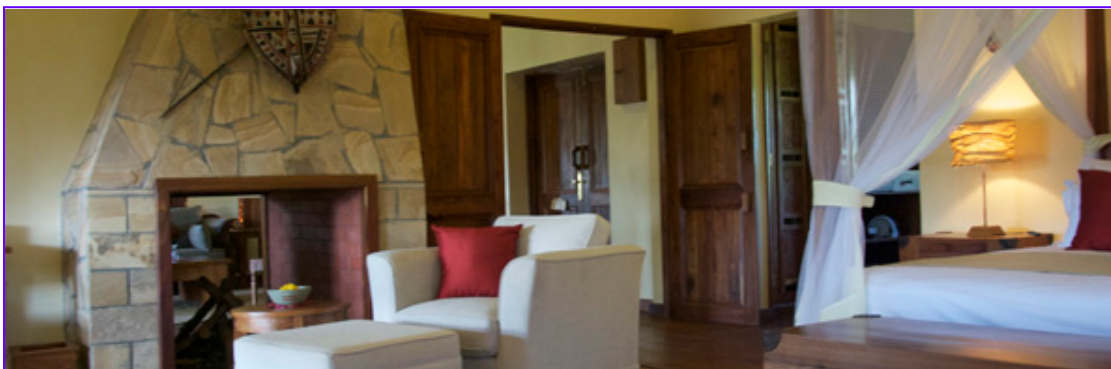
Mt. Meru Game Lodge and Sanctuary

Nestled between the peaks of Mount Meru and Mount Kilimanjaro, Mount Meru Game Lodge & Sanctuary lies midway between Kilimanjaro International Airport and Arusha. The Lodge is located within 33 acres of mature, well-manicured gardens bounded on one side by the tranquil waters of the Usa River and on the other by the Animal Sanctuary where resident animals and birds reside. This wildlife provides many guests with their first exciting game viewing experience. The main emphasis of the Game Sanctuary is to provide safe haven to African plains game and birds. These include eland, ostriches, waterbucks, zebras, buffalo, small carnivores such as Monitor lizards, small wild cats and of course the enormous variety of birdlife who come to feed, breed and enjoy the unique freedom offered by our very safe environment. The lodge comprises 15 double or twin en-suite bedrooms and 2 suites, each with a unique design and character. All rooms have a veranda with comfortable chairs where guests may sit during the late afternoons enjoying the peace of the surroundings, soaking up the unique atmosphere of the Lodge and watching the animal and birdlife. The suites are located in their own private garden and are ideal also for families and small groups to whom privacy is very important.

Day 8 ~ February 17: Lake Manyara National Park

After breakfast travel to Lake Manyara National Park for game viewing and a picnic lunch in the Park. While small in size, Manyara is important from an ecological standpoint as it contains five different ecosystems within its boundary. It is also famous for its tree-climbing lion which hopefully you will be able to witness. In the afternoon continue on to Ngorongoro Crater stopping en route at Mto wa Mbu where visitors will get a chance to meet locals and learn about banana beer, Makonde woodcarvings, and the tribal painting techniques; the village provides a great introduction to everyday life in Africa. Continue to your lodge for dinner and overnight.

Exploreans Ngorongoro Lodge

Set in 50 acres of virgin Tanzanian bush in the Ngorongoro volcanic landscape, Exploreans is located a few steps from the Game Reserve Gate and 20 minutes drive away from the Ngorongoro Crater. This all inclusive property features 20 spacious private log cabins with fire place, a restaurant, a bar and conference facilities. Indulge in moments of relaxation at the swimming pool or at the Mvua African Rain Spa after a full-day game drive. Twenty luxury suites are offered as individual cottages with open fire places in the bedroom and living room and large private viewing terraces with sofa and dining area. Facilities in the room include King Size canopy bed with fine linens, butler on call, en-suite facilities with solar water heating, spacious bathroom, large shower, two hand wash basins, comfortable living room with armchairs, sofa bed and coffee table, and in-room safe.

Day 9 ~ February 18: Ngorongoro Crater

After breakfast enjoying views of the volcanic caldera, you will descend into the World Heritage Site Ngorongoro Crater for several hours of game viewing. This sunken caldera contains the largest concentration of wildlife to be found on the African Continent – over 20,000 at all times. It is also one of the few remaining places where you might be able to witness the endangered black rhino in its natural habitat. Indigenous to this area only is the very handsome black mane lion. A picnic lunch will be enjoyed at mid-day in the Crater. In the afternoon continue on to the Ngorongoro Conservation area, while game driving en route. Arrive at your mobile tented camp for dinner and a unique lodging experience! Dinner and overnight at **[Masek Under Canvas Tented Camp](#) – Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner**



Masek Under Canvas Tented Camp

Nestled between the prime wildlife areas of central and southern Serengeti, Masek Under Canvas enables guests to be within reach of the Great Migration and to explore remote, beautiful corners of the Serengeti with excellent resident game. This seasonal camp is intimate and exclusive, offering the most spacious safari tents, each with large king size beds or twin beds, en suite bathroom, separate portable flush toilet and a bucket shower. The intimate setting includes ten tents at the campsite where you will enjoy the exclusivity of absolute comfort combined with the authenticity of nights spent in the African bush - an extraordinary experience for all nature lovers. Lighting is supplied by solar energy, meals are enjoyed in the mess tent, and relax in the lounge tent with a drink. Your experience is inclusive of all meals and beverages.

Day 10/11 ~ February 19/20: Ngorongoro Conservation Area and Serengeti NP

You will spend the next two days game viewing in the Northern Ngorongoro Area and Serengeti National Park. This area of East Africa's savannah plains has attracted humans for millennia. The whole area is now colloquially known as the short grass plains and is the preferred habitat of hundreds of thousands

(perhaps more than a million) of wildebeest. They feel safest here, choosing this location year after year to give birth to their young. On one of these days you can take an optional hot air balloon ride in the area.

Overnight Masek Under Canvas Tented Camp – Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner

HOT AIR BALLOON SAFARI

The evening before your hot air balloon safari a representative will meet with you to brief you on the safari and have you complete some paperwork. The next morning you will awaken to coffee and tea set out by the lodge prior to your early departure. A Land Rover will transfer you to the launch site where you will meet your pilot, receive a briefing and watch the inflation of the balloon. At dawn you and balloon will take off, rising as the sun rises and float in whichever direction the winds of the morning take you. Your pilot can precisely control the altitude of your balloon – sometimes flying at treetop height, sometime lower, offering a unique perspective and great photographic opportunities of the wildlife below. At other times the pilot will ascend to 1000' or more to see the enormity and wonderful panorama of the Serengeti. As the balloon lands enjoy a champagne toast to your majestic ride. Then proceed to your table under the shade of a classic umbrella tree on the Serengeti Plains, where you will enjoy a traditional English breakfast.



Day 12 ~ February 21: Depart for U.S.

After an early morning breakfast, return to Arusha for a lunch. Enjoy a day room at Mt. Meru Game Lodge where you can relax, repack and shower. Transfer to the airport for your international flight home.

Day 13 ~ February 22: Return to the U.S.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF TRAVEL

HOW TO BOOK: Fill out the reservation form and send it to Ujuzi African Travel, 4150 N. Farwell St., Shorewood, WI 53211, together with a deposit of \$2,500 per person for the safari package. On receipt of your signed reservation form and deposit, we (Ujuzi African Travel, LLC or "UAT") will, subject to availability, reserve your place on a tour/safari/trek. When we send your confirmation invoice, your booking is confirmed and you have a contract with us. Final payment is due no later than 90 days prior to departure. Final documents will be sent to you approximately four to five weeks prior to departure. (Please initial)

AIR TRANSPORTATION:

International. Your safari will start in Kigali, Rwanda and end in Arusha Tanzania. UAT offers a service to book airline tickets for its clients for international flights – see the RESERVATION FORM – as well as from any destination in Africa. UAT will book your international flight from the U.S.A. to Kigali, Rwanda and from Arusha, Tanzania, unless noted otherwise. The payment for these flights will be arranged separately from the tour booking and will be charged directly to your credit card. (Please initial)

Departure Taxes. NOTICE - the amount of departure tax required to be paid with your airfare is subject to change without advance notice, at the discretion of governments and airlines. Should such a change occur, you will be invoiced prior to departure for any additional taxes imposed. **Departure tax and air fees are non-refundable.** (Please initial)

Baggage: International flights from the US allow two pieces of checked luggage, each not exceeding 50 lbs. However we recommend you travel as light as you can manage, and preferably bring one bag. Additionally, your regional flight from Rwanda to Tanzania allows a weight limit for checked and carry-on baggage of 45 lbs. total. Also, the size and the structure of the bag are limited. Soft duffel bags are ideal. Large suitcases are virtually impossible to stow on smaller aircraft and vehicles and should not be used. Consider bringing a small backpack as one of your carry-ons, shared between two people. A backpack will be convenient when seeing the wildlife, and on our walks and boat rides. Travel insurance covers delayed or lost baggage.

SUPPLIERS OF SERVICES: Unless the term "guaranteed" is specifically stated in writing on your ticket, invoice, or reservation itinerary, Ujuzi African Travel does not guarantee any airline's or other supplier's rates, bookings, reservations, connections, scheduling, or handling of baggage or other personal effects. We have researched and typically have experience with the suppliers we recommend. You acknowledge, however, that the ticket issued to you by the airline or other supplier constitutes the sole contract between you and the supplier. UAT acts only as an intermediary between you and the suppliers. (Please initial)

REPLACEMENTS: We reserve the right to make small modifications to your tour which will not change your payment obligations. For example, if one of the guides reserved for your tour/safari/trek is unexpectedly unable to take your group, we will substitute with another guide; or we may have to replace a transportation supplier for a leg of your tour; on rare occasions, we may have to replace the lodging listed in your itinerary to different but equivalent lodging. (Please initial)

DELAYS: If an airline delay or any other reason causes you to miss the start or your safari, we are not liable for your missing the next or any leg of your tour, nor are we liable for any additional costs incurred as a result of the delay. (Please initial)

ACCOMMODATIONS: You will marvel at the wonderful accommodations provided throughout your tour. All rooms have private facilities. All rates are based on double occupancy, that is, two people sharing a room. Most rooms are twin-bedded. Single occupancy rooms, if available, will be assigned on a first-come-first-served basis at additional cost (see reservation form for the cost). With single occupancy you may gain privacy, but, typically, not additional amenities. On occasion, in smaller lodges and camps, you may be required to share lodging with another member of your tour group if single rooms are not available. For passengers who are travelling alone and wish to share a room with another tour member, we will do our best to provide a roommate. However, if this is not possible, you will be required to pay the single occupancy supplement prior to your departure from the U.S.A. The accommodations listed in your itinerary are current as of September 2013. (Please initial)

MEALS: No meals are provided by UAT on your travel to Kigali, Rwanda or on your return travel to the U.S.A. (such meals, however, may be provided by your airline). Meals are provided with your safari package.

WILDLIFE VIEWING: All wildlife viewing in Rwanda and Tanzania is by 4x4 open-air vehicles, driven by a local driver. You and all in your group will be able to sit in a window seat. **NO SMOKING WILL BE ALLOWED IN VEHICLES.**

TOUR INFORMATION: Upon receipt of your completed reservation application, instructions and information will be sent to you concerning almost all aspects of your trip, including an itinerary, photographic equipment, documents, clothing, insurance, etc.

RATES: All rates quoted are based on tariffs in effect and the value of foreign currencies in relation to the U.S. dollar as of September 2013 and are subject to change. All charges and fees are quoted in U.S. dollars. Tour pricing and rates will be re-quoted as we receive new information. (Please initial)

TIPS AND TAXES: Service charges and taxes imposed by hotels, lodges and tented camps; entrance fees; are all included in the price of your tour package in Rwanda. Tips for your driver guide, accommodation, meals and beverages, and transport are included in the package. You are welcome to make an additional tip to any supplier at your discretion. (Please initial)
