Palmetto Community Action Partnership's Project Pride department is currently accepting applications for the *Summer Youth Works! 2015* seasonal employment program.

Summer Youth Works! allows young people to gain work experience in assorted career fields and earn income during a time they might otherwise not be working.



About the Program

The mission of the *Summer Youth Works!* program is to provide a solid foundation for youth to enhance skills of self-sufficiency and develop a strong work ethic for their generation's workforce. Young people work with diverse community partners in various paid positions at sites around the Tri-county area during the Summer months to develop soft skills and professional experience in this highly competitive program.

Project Pride is the Employment and work support division of Palmetto Community Action Partnership (Palmetto CAP). Palmetto CAP is the Community Action Agency that serve the economically disadvantaged residents of Charleston, Berkeley, and Dorchester counties with basic needs assistance, emergency services and self-sufficiency programs. All programs and services are provided free of charge.

Eligibility Requirements for Program Participants

- Must live in the agency service area (Berkeley, Charleston, or Dorchester County)
- If a college student, primary residence must be in agency service area
- Must be a Junior in high school taking College prep courses*
- Must be a Senior in high school with a letter of acceptance from an accredited college (community, technical or 4-year)
- If a current college student, must be planning to return to college in August 2015**

*=Will have to provide most recent report card

**=Will have to provide Fall 2015 class schedule

Candidates chosen to participate in the program will have to complete a background check, drug screen and the interview process with job sites.
