



TOUR TO GREECE & TURKEY

July 8-21, 2016

Dr. Moseley teaches Religion, Biblical Studies & Philosophy at The Bishop's School, La Jolla; has been an Adjunct Faculty at USD since 1997; and teaches Church Adult Education Classes throughout San Diego. Dr. Moseley holds Undergraduate and Graduate Degrees from Oxford and Cambridge Universities, U.K. He has traveled to more than 40 Countries, and has led many trips to the Holy Land, India and Africa.

Day 1 - July 8: Depart U.S.A.

Our trip begins as we depart on our transatlantic flight to Turkey. Meals and refreshments will be served aloft.

Day 2 - July 9: Arrive Istanbul

Upon arrival in Istanbul we will be met at the airport by our local guide and then drive to our hotel for check-in. (D)

Day 3 - July 10: Istanbul

This morning we will visit the Hagia Sophia which is one of the Seven Wonders of the World and has a history dating back to the 4th Century. Then proceed to the Basilica Cistern, an “underground cathedral” built by Emperor Justinian. The remainder of the afternoon will be free, or you may wish to take an optional tour to visit the Archeological Museum and St. Savior in Chora Church. (B/D)



Day 4 - July 11: Istanbul

Visit the famous Blue Mosque with its six minarets and sparkling interior. Next, visit Topkapi Palace, the residence of the Ottoman Sultans, where we will view the Treasury and the world’s biggest emerald. In the afternoon embark on a cruise along the Bosphorus, the winding strait separating Europe and Asia. Shopping in the Grand Bazaar, the oldest and largest covered market in the world where over 4,000 shops sell everything from herbs to gold. This evening enjoy an early dinner at a fish restaurant on the Bosphorus. (B/D)



Day 5 - July 12: Istanbul / Canakkale

Depart Istanbul and drive along the Sea of Marmara and across the Dardanelles to Gallipoli, the famous site of the World War One battle. Continue on to legendary Troy to see the city made

famous in Homer’s poems and visit Troas where St. Paul had a vision in which he was called to Macedonia. Proceed on to Canakkale for overnight. (B/D)

Day 6 - July 13: Canakkale / Izmir

Depart Canakkale and drive to visit Pergamum, the most favored of the Seven Churches of Revelation where Christianity was introduced very early. Here we will see the Temple of Zeus, the Temple of Athena, the fabled Acropolis and the Royal Gate. We will also visit Asclepion, one the foremost healing centers of the ancient world. Continue on to Thyatira, another of the Seven Churches. Then visit the Church of St. Polycarp, which is the oldest church in ancient Smyrna and is dedicated to one of the first Christian martyrs. Proceed to Izmir for overnight. (B/D)

Day 7 - July 14: Izmir / Pamukale

Depart Izmir and drive to Sardis, the Lydian capital city where money was first minted, to visit the Roman Gymnasium and the remains of the Artemis Temple which symbolized one of the Seven Churches. We will then stop at Philadelphia which was referred to as the “New Jerusalem”. Proceed to the spa city of Pamukale where we will see the cascading water from the cliffs forming crystallized, dazzling white “frozen waterfalls”. Visit the ruins of the Roman health spa of Hierapolis and see the magnificently preserved Necropolis, the Main Street and Gates. Overnight in Pamukale. (B/D)



Day 8 - July 15: Pamukale / Kusadasi

Depart Pamukale this morning and drive to visit Laodicea, one of the Seven Churches where Christians were chastised by John of Patmos in Revelation for being “lukewarm.” Then proceed to the ancient city of Ephesus to visit the site of the Temple of Artemis (Diana) which is one of the Seven Wonders of the World. Paul spent two years in Ephesus and it was to this community that he wrote his Epistle to the Ephesians. Paul implored the Ephesians to cease their worship of Artemis and to turn to Christianity. We will see the great theater where Paul addressed the crowds, and visit the site of the scene of the riot from which Paul escaped. Visit the Church of the Virgin Mary, the House of Mary, and the Tomb of St. Luke. While driving to the colorful port of Kusadasi, we will visit the Basilica of St. John, which was erected over his grave in the 6th Century C.E. by the Emperor Justinian, and the Ephesus Museum in Selcuk. (B/D)



Day 9 - July 16: Kusadasi / Patmos *

This morning we will transfer to the pier at Kusadasi to embark on a three-day cruise of the Greek Isles. This afternoon we will arrive at the island of Patmos where St. John received the mystical Revelation which forms the last book of the New Testament. You may wish to visit the island on your own or take an optional excursion to the Grotto of Revelation and the 11th Century Monastery of St. John which houses many ancient biblical manuscripts. (B/L/D)

Day 10 - July 17: Heraklion * / Santorini *

This morning we arrive at the port of Heraklion on the island of Crete, the southernmost of the Greek Isles and the legendary birthplace of the Greek god Zeus. Heraklion, the capital of Crete, and its principal commercial port, is just three miles away from the fantastic ruins of the Palace of Knossos which is believed to be the mythical Labyrinth of King Minos. You may wish to visit the island on your own or take an optional excursion. After visiting Crete we will set sail and arrive on the island of Santorini. Take time to explore this gorgeous island and stroll through its quaint winding streets and whitewashed alleys and enjoy the local flavor of its many cafes and tavernas. (B/L/D)

Day 11 - July 18: Piraeus / Athens

After disembarking at Piraeus we will drive to ancient Corinth, the city that inspired some of St. Paul's most familiar letters. We will stand in the midst of the ruins of the church of Corinth and see the ancient pillars, steps, and public worship place where Paul preached. We will then proceed to Athens for check-in at our hotel. (B/D)



Day 12 - July 19: Athens

Today we will enjoy an excursion to the magnificent archeological site of the ancient City of Delphi which contains some of the best remains from Greek Classical Antiquity (6th

Century B.C.E.). After a complete tour of Delphi we will return to Athens for overnight. (B/D)

Days 13 - July 20: Athens

This morning we will enjoy a tour of Athens starting with a visit to the ancient Acropolis with its Parthenon. We'll stroll through the Ancient Agora where Socrates, Plato, and - much later - St. Paul spoke to the people of Athens. Then we'll head over to the National Archeological Museum for a guided tour of one of the world's greatest museums. The remainder of the afternoon is free. This evening enjoy a farewell dinner on the Plaka. (B/D)

Day 14 - July 21: Athens / U.S.A.

Transfer to Athens airport to catch our return flight home.

** There will be a variety of optional shore excursions offered by the cruise ship while docked at Patmos and Heraklion and these excursions are NOT included in the tour cost. In Santorini a private walking tour with your tour manager is included in the trip cost; however you may still opt to take one of the cruise ship's optional shore excursions if desired. Information on the shore excursions offered by the cruise ship will be included in your final tour documents or are available upon request.*

GENERAL INFORMATION AND CONDITIONS

Reservations and Payment: Please complete the attached Reservation Application and return it with your deposit of \$300.00 per person at the time of booking. Final payment is due 65 days prior to departure.

Cancellations: All cancellations must be in writing. The following per person cancellation charges will apply: If canceled 91 days or more prior to departure, a \$50.00 administrative fee will be charged. If canceled 90 - 61 days prior to departure, \$250.00 will be charged. If canceled 60 - 31 days prior to departure, \$450.00 will be charged. If canceled 30 - 7 days prior to departure \$700.00 will be charged. No refunds will be made within 6 days of departure. In addition, once the airline tickets have been issued, 100% of the airfare is non-refundable unless you have been advised otherwise at the time of your booking. Additional cancellation charges may apply depending upon the cancellation terms of our suppliers.

Refunds: Subject to the foregoing Cancellation Terms, upon cancellation of travel related services, all sums paid to George's International Tours for such services will be promptly returned to the passenger, provided the passenger has not caused such cancellation and is not in violation of any of the terms and conditions previously, clearly and conspicuously disclosed and agreed to by the passenger. This refund provision does not apply where George's International Tours has remitted the payment to another registered seller of travel or a carrier and they default in providing the agreed-upon transportation or service without providing a refund. In such a situation, George's International Tours agrees to provide passenger with a written statement accompanied by a copy of the bank records establishing the disbursement of the payment, and if disbursed to a seller of travel, proof of their current registration.

Trust Account Disclosure: California law requires certain sellers of travel to have a trust account or bond. George's International Tours has such a trust account.

Travel Consumer Restitution Corporation ("TCRC"): George's International Tours is a participant in the Travel Consumer Restitution Corporation ("TCRC"). You, the passenger, may request reimbursement from TCRC if the Seller of Travel was registered and participating in the TCRC at the time of sale and the passenger is located in California at the time of payment. Please be advised that passengers purchasing from outside of California are not covered by the TCRC. Eligible passengers may file a claim with TCRC if the passenger is owed a refund of more than \$50 for transportation or travel services which the Seller of Travel failed to forward to a proper provider or if such money was not refunded to you when required. The maximum amount which may be paid by the TCRC to any one passenger is the total amount paid on behalf of the passenger to the Seller of Travel, not to exceed \$15,000. A claim must be submitted to the TCRC within six months after the scheduled completion date of the travel. A claim must include sufficient information and documentation to prove your claim and a \$35 processing fee. You must agree to waive your right to other civil remedies against a registered participating Seller of Travel for matters arising out of a sale for which you file a claim with the TCRC, if you were located in California at the time of the sale. You may request a claim form by writing to: Travel Consumer Restitution Corporation, P.O. Box 6001, Larkspur, CA 94977-6001; or by faxing a request to 415-927-7698.

Travel Documents: A passport with a minimum of 6 months validity remaining is required of all U. S. citizens. U.S. citizens do not require visas for entry to Greece, but visas are required for entry to Turkey. The fee for the Turkish visa is \$20.00 per person for U.S. citizens and the visa needs to be prearranged prior to departure from the United States. Turkey has adopted a new "e-visa" which can easily be obtained online by visiting www.evisa.gov.tr. If you are not a U. S. citizen, please call to find out if you need a visa for Greece or Turkey. George's International is not responsible for individual visas or passports.

Tour Cost: All quoted prices are based upon fares, tariffs and currency exchange rates at the time of printing and are subject to change at any time. Should the minimum number of 20 tour members not be reached, the right is reserved to increase the tour cost accordingly.

Tour Documents and Tickets: Final tour documents are mailed, provided we have received full payment, within 3 weeks of departure.

Baggage: Each passenger is allowed one checked bag and one carry-on. You will be responsible for paying to the airline any additional charges for additional checked baggage or overweight baggage (if excess weight is permitted). George's International Tours is not responsible for lost, damaged or stolen baggage.

Air Transportation: Air travel is in economy class on Turkish Airlines (or any other IATA carrier). Fares are based upon levels in effect at the time of printing. Fares and flight schedules are subject to change without notice.

Hotels: Accommodations are based on double occupancy rooms. A limited number of single rooms are available at the supplement quoted, and should be requested at the time of booking.

Travel Insurance: We strongly recommend that you have comprehensive travel insurance. Insurance may be purchased directly through George's International Tours and registration forms will be provided upon receipt of your deposit or you may purchase online at www.georgesintl.com.
