## Lodging:

Overnight lodging is available for up to 90 guests in comfortable, modest rooms with European-style restroom facilities.



## Meeting Rooms:

All meeting rooms include a tv with dvd player, whiteboard and podium; some include a piano. Rooms can be arranged theater style, classroom, prayer circle, or boardroom style. Complimentary wireless internet access is provided.



**Dining Room:** We offer a delicious buffet style menu for breakfast, lunch and dinner prepared from scratch in our Old Mission Kitchen. Various snack and treat options are also available and made fresh to order.



**O'Keefe Lounge:** Help yourself to coffee, tea or water in the O'Keefe Lounge located in the main courtyard. It is open 24 hours and is a great place to relax.



**St. Clare Chapel:** Groups may reserve times for Chapel use; those reservations must be made before arrival. When the Chapel is not in use by a group it is available for silence and reflection.

**Outdoor Facilities:** The 56 acre campus offers many outdoor areas for meditation and relaxation. They include a swimming pool, basketball/volleyball court, gardens and pavilion.

**Stations of the Cross:** The Stations start behind the pool and line the path around the back field of the Mission property.



**Mission Historic Church:** The Historic Church is open to the public for prayer and meditation from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. daily. There is a daily 12pm mass in the Historic Church, Monday through Friday, and a Sunday Mass is celebrated at 7am in the Historic Church. The Old Mission Historic Church is also used for funerals, weddings and special celebrations.



**Mission Gift Shop:** As a retreat center guest, you can receive a 10% discount at our Old Mission Gift Shop which offers specialized gifts including: sacred art, jewelry, Baptism & First Communion items, books, unique rosaries & crosses, Native American art, one-of-a-kind souvenirs and collectibles. Open daily, 10am – 4:30pm.

**Mission Museum:** The Museum houses exhibits relating to the unique and colorful history of Mission San Luis Rey de Francia. Its collections include artifacts from Native American, Spanish Mission, Mexican Secularization, and American Military periods. Open daily, 10 am-4 pm.
