Please find enclosed the necessary forms to assist you in conducting your local school elections during the month of May. We are aware that some schools were unable to conduct local elections according to schedule due to city-wide excessing of staff. We are requesting that all Building Representatives adhere to the timeframes/notice period set forth in our WTU Constitution and By-Laws to ensure that your elections are completed. The time, date and place of the election shall be decided by the SCAC with provisions made so that all members in good standing have a reasonable opportunity to vote. **Please submit your results to the WTU Office by no later than May 31, 2016.**

Sample Timeframe:

- By Friday, May 6, 2016......Post Notice of Nominations and Elections
- By Friday, May 13, 2016......Conduct Nominations Meeting
- By Friday, May 20, 2016......Conduct Secret Ballot Voting
- By Tuesday, May 31, 2016......Submit Election Results to the WTU Office

ELECTION GUIDELINES AND PROCEDURES

- 1. Only *full dues paying members* (\$36.08) are eligible to nominate and vote in the election for the <u>WTU Building Representative</u>, members of the <u>School Chapter Advisory Committee (SCAC)</u> and members of the <u>Representative Assembly</u>.
- 2. <u>All</u> bargaining unit members, including *full dues paying members* and *Agency fee members* (\$30.67) are allowed to nominate and vote in the election of members to serve on the <u>Local School Advisory Team</u> and the <u>Personnel Committee</u>.
- 3. Elections shall be held by secret ballot and there shall be no absentee balloting.
- 4. The <u>Building Representative</u> election shall be conducted by members who are not candidates. All other elections shall be conducted by the Building Representative.
- 5. Nominations may be submitted in writing, by the close of school, two (2) days prior to the election. Written nominations should be submitted only after verifying that the nominee is willing to serve. The Building Representative shall give written verification for any written nominations received.
- 6. Printed ballots shall list all names alphabetically.
- 7. The time, date, and place of the election shall be decided by the SCAC with provisions made so that all members in good standing shall have a reasonable opportunity to vote.
- 8. Use the enclosed nomination and election bulletin to specify the date, time, and place for the nominations meeting and election. The nominations meeting shall be held at least five (5) school days in advance of the election.
- 9. The Building Representative and SCAC must establish a Tally Committee to count ballots. No person running for office can serve on the Tally Committee. All candidates shall have the right to have observers when the ballots are tallied.
- 10. The Building Representative shall secure and hold all election materials/results until **September 6, 2017.**
- 11. Challenges to the elections for all positions shall be submitted in writing to the Executive Board for appropriate action within fifteen (15) days after the election.



ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Local School Positions

Building Representative- An elected representative for the Union, or a Union designee in each school, school administrative unit, or school functional unit shall serve as chairperson of the School Chapter Advisory Committee.

Alternate Delegate- The elected alternate delegate will attend Representative Assembly meetings when the Building Representative is unable to attend.

School Chapter Advisory Committee- The SCAC committee should consist of not more than seven (7) members of the Union in each school, school administrative unit, or school functional unit. There shall be only one School Chapter Advisory Committee in each school, school administrative unit, or school functional unit regardless of the number of bargaining units represented by the Union, except where there is more than one supervisor.

Local School Advisory Team- A consensus group of administrators, parents, teachers, support staff, union representative, community representative and students who are elected and/or appointed to advise on matters of local school policy.

Personnel Committee- Each school will have a standing Personnel Committee who will interview and recommend all candidates for any vacant positions at the school. The members of the Personnel Committee will include: the administrator or his/her designee; the WTU Building Representative or his/her designee; the department head or grade level chairperson (or his/her designee) from the department or grade level affected by the vacancy, or a member of the appropriate non-Teacher employee group (e.g., custodians, paraprofessionals); at least one additional Teacher, but not more than (4), elected by the WTU chapter at the school; and a parent of a current student mutually selected by both WTU Building Representative and the Supervisor.

After interviewing the candidates, the Personnel Committee will rank the candidates in order of preference using a consensus method. This recommendation will be forwarded to the administrator, who will make the final hiring decision from those ranked by the committee (Reference WTU contract; page 6).

Representative Assembly- Subject to the final authority of the membership, the general governing body of the WTU shall be the Representative Assembly. This assembly shall consist of members of the WTU who are elected by the members. Elections for the Assembly shall be as follows:

- A. Representative Assembly members shall be apportioned on the basis of one for every twenty-five members, or major portion thereof, in good standing in the Union with not less than one representative per building.
- B. The Building Representative or his/her designee shall be the ranking delegate from each building.
