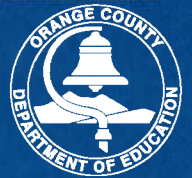




# Volunteers are needed for the Orange County Academic Decathlon

**Saturday, January 30 at Tustin High School**  
Interview Judges and Speech Judges needed

**Interview Judge** – As an Interview Judge, you will be placed on a panel of community members to interview students (similar to a job interview) using guidelines and scoring forms provided.

**Speech Judge** – As a Speech Judge, you will be placed with a team of community members to observe and evaluate student speeches using guidelines and scoring forms provided.

- \* All judges attend an orientation on the morning of the event.

Test Proctors needed

**Test Proctor** – As a Test Proctor, you will be teamed up with another community member to administer tests to a classroom of 30 students. All proctors attend an orientation on the morning of the event.
