Dr. Stephan Glatt
2014 Connie Lieber Research Award Recipient



Stephen J. Glatt, Ph.D., is Associate Professor of Psychiatry & Behavioral Sciences and of Neuroscience & Physiology, Associate Director of Psychiatry Research, Associate Director of the Medical Genetics Research Center, and Director of the Psychiatric Genetic Epidemiology & Neurobiology Laboratory (PsychGENe Lab) at SUNY Upstate Medical University in Syracuse, New York.

Dr. Glatt has been awarded two Young Investigator Awards, an Independent Investigator Award, and the Sidney R. Baer, Jr. Prize for Schizophrenia Research from NARSAD: The Brain and Behavior Research Foundation. He is also the Principal Investigator on two Research Project grants (R01s) from the National Institute of Mental Health. Dr. Glatt is also a co-investigator or consultant on numerous grants from the National Institutes of Health which are focused on identifying the nature and causes of mental disorders.

Dr. Glatt is an author on 100 journal articles, over 10 book chapters, and one book, “*Schizophrenia: The Facts*”. Dr. Glatt is on the Editorial Board of *Neuropsychiatric Genetics*, the official journal of the International Society of Psychiatric Genetics, and serves as an *ad hoc* reviewer for many of the top journals in the field of psychiatry, including *Archives of General Psychiatry*, *American Journal of Psychiatry*, *Molecular Psychiatry*, and *Biological Psychiatry*. In addition, he serves as Editor-at-Large for Methodology and Statistics for the *Journal of the American Academy of Child and Adolescent Psychiatry*.
