District Export Councils (DECs) are organizations of business leaders from local communities, appointed by a U.S. Secretary of Commerce. These leaders have knowledge of and expertise in international business, and they support their region's export efforts. "It is an honor to be elected as Vice Chair of the Virginia/DC DEC," said Aaron S. Miller, International Trade Manager at the Virginia SBDC Network. "DECs' work with exporting goods and services strengthen individual companies, stimulate the US economy, and create jobs."

Closely affiliated with the U.S. Commerce Department's Export Assistance Centers and the U.S. and Foreign Commercial Service, the 59 DEC expansion activities are accomplished by working with the U.S. Export Assistance Centers to provide opportunities to promote greater export activity at the local level while developing a trade assistance network.
