# Recap Of FY 15 Program


## FY 15 Program "Dynamics"

- □ Federal Funding Slightly Exceeded Expectations
  - > Federal Funding Was Within 1.2% Of Estimate
    - \$39 Million Received Thru "Redistribution" Was \$24 Million
      More Than Anticipated
    - □ Offset a \$15 Million Shortfall In Expected Formula Funds
- □ State Highway Improvement Program funding decreased Overall
  - > \$76 Million More In Additional State Obligation Authority for SHR, MAJORS, SE MEGA
  - > \$226 Million Less Funding in 304 Bridge Program (HOAN)

## FY 15 Program "Dynamics"

- □ Lets Totaled 2% More Than PS&E Estimates
  - > \$21.6 Million In "Negative" Let Savings
  - > \$30.5 Million In "Negative" Let Savings if ZOO excluded.
- □ Project Mix Changes During The Year
  - > 76 Lets Moved Out Of The Program (22% Of Projects)
  - > 33 Lets Moved In To The Program



#### 12 Year History Of Lets



[Index 2003 = 100]




## Let History In Constant Dollars






## FY 15 Monthly Lets

- 2. Reserve Funding For Design/Construction Engineering And Contract Change Orders
- 3. Update Project Cost Estimates
- 4. Finalize Schedule Of Lets And Non-Lets Within Funds Available
- 5. Identify Contingency Projects To Have Ready In Case They're Needed

#### Let Level Caveats

#### □ Federal FY 16 Funding

- > Concern Is Actual Federal Funds vs. Chapter 20 Estimate
- > Redistribution \$21 Million Above Chapter 20 Estimate
- Expected Formula Funds Estimated at \$15 Million Below Chapter 20 Estimate
- > So, Maybe \$5-6 Million Above Chapter 20?
- □ State Motor Fuel And Registration Revenue Collections






#### Estimated Concrete Quantities For FY 16




#### Estimated Excavation Quantities For FY 16






#### Estimated Base Course Quantities For FY 16











#### Estimated Rubblizing Quantities For FY 16




#### Estimated Striping Quantities For FY 16
